ORDER APPROVING FINAL APPLICATION OF LAZARD FRERES & CO., LLC FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 330 AND 331 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE

On July 10, 2000, Lazard Freres & Co., LLC, investment banker to the Debtors in the above-referenced Chapter 11 cases filed its Final Application for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for out-of-pocket expenses incurred during the period February 1, 2000 through May 26, 2000, as well as for final approval of all fees and expenses previously paid in these Chapter 11 bankruptcy cases ("Final Application") to Lazard Freres & Co., LLC and its predecessor BT Alex Brown (collectively referred to as "Lazard").

Pursuant to its Final Application, Lazard applied for a total of \$2.1 million in payment for its fees and \$99,738.34 for payment of its expenses for work done in the

Debtor's bankruptcy cases. Lazard also requested payment of an Incremental Fee in the amount of \$1,801,250.00 based on a calculated percentage of the total value of the sale of the Debtor's assets. The total compensation Lazard applied for was \$4,000,988.34. Lazard had already been paid a total of \$2,112,708.39 as interim compensation approved by this Court.

On August 22, 2000, Gerald K. Smith, Boston Chicken Plan Trustee (the "Trustee"), objected to \$1,375,375.00 of Lazard's fees, all of Lazard's expenses of \$99,738.34, and a portion of the requested Incremental Fee.

The Trustee and Lazard have now entered into a Stipulation which provides that Lazard should be paid a total of \$3,725,565.00, which represents payment of Lazard's expenses in the amount of \$99,738.00, an Incremental Fee in the amount of \$1,650,827.00, and monthly fees totaling \$1,975,000.00. Based thereon, the Trustee has withdrawn his objection to Lazard's Application.

There are sufficient unencumbered funds under the control of the Trustee to immediately pay the balance due Lazard in full.

In light of the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the Final Application for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses filed by Lazard meets the requirements for an award of compensation to professionals under 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(1)(A)&(B) by application of the provisions of 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(3)(A).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Final Application is approved and Lazard is awarded total compensation in the amount of \$3,725,565.00;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Trustee is directed to pay Lazard forthwith the sum of \$1,612,856.61 (representing the balance due to Lazard after deducting amounts previously paid to Lazard and BT Alex Brown as interim compensation);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the aggregate award to Lazard of \$3,725,565.00 constitutes a final award of fees and expenses due Lazard and BT Alex Brown in these cases.
