VERIFIED APPLICATION OF FRIED, FRANK, HARRIS, SHRIVER & JACOBSON, AS CO-COUNSEL TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS OF THE HOLDING COMPANY DEBTORS, FOR INTERIM COMPENSATION FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RENDERED AND FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED DURING THE PERIOD FROM JUNE 1, 2003 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2003

Pursuant to sections 328, 330 and 331 of title 11 of the United States Code (as amended, the "Bankruptcy Code"), Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2016 (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), rule 607 of the Bankruptcy Rules for the United States District Court and the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Illinois (the "Local Bankruptcy Rules"), the Retention Order (as defined below) and that certain Administrative Order Under Sections 105(a) and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Professionals and Committee Members (the "Interim Compensation Order"), the

The Debtors are the following entities: (i) Conseco, Inc., CIHC, Incorporated, CTIHC, Inc., Partners Health Group, Inc. (collectively, the "Holding Company Debtors"), (ii) Conseco Finance Corp., Conseco Finance Servicing Corp. (collectively, the "CFC Initial Debtors"), (iii) Conseco Finance Corp. – Alabama, Conseco Finance Credit Corp., Conseco Finance Consumer Discount Company, Conseco Finance Canada Holding Company, Conseco Finance Canada Company, Conseco Finance Loan Company, Rice Park Properties Corporation, Landmark Manufactured Housing, Inc., Conseco Finance Not Interest Margin Finance Corp. law firm of Fried, Frank, Harris, Shriver & Jacobson ("FFHS&J"), counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of the Holding Company Debtors (the "Committee") in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (the "Chapter 11 Cases"), hereby applies (the "Application") for (i) interim compensation for professional services rendered on behalf of the Committee in the amount of \$531,057.15, which represents 90% of the \$590,063.50 in services billed (the "Fees"), and (ii) reimbursement in the amount of \$65,939.30 for the actual and necessary expenses that FFHS&J incurred (the "Expenses"), in each case for the period from June 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 (the "Sixth Monthly Fee Period"). The detailed billing records for the Fees and Expenses sought in this Application are attached as Exhibits A and B, respectively. In support of this Application, FFHS&J respectfully states as follows:

Background

- 1. On December 17, 2002 (the "Petition Date"), each of the Debtors filed its respective voluntary petition for relief under the Bankruptcy Code.²
- 2. On January 3, 2003, the United States Trustee appointed the members of the Committee at the Committee formation meeting (the "Committee Formation Meeting"). On that date, the Committee proceeded to retain, subject to Bankruptcy Court approval, FFIIS&J and Mayer, Brown, Rowc & Maw ("Mayer Brown") as its co-counsel, and Houlihan Lokey Howard & Zukin and Greenhill & Co., LLC as its financial advisors.
- 3. By this Court's order dated February 12, 2003, the Committee was authorized to retain FFHS&J as their counsel, effective as of January 3, 2003, with regard to the representation of the Committee during the Chapter 11 Cases and all related matters (the "Retention Order"). The Retention Order authorizes the Debtors to compensate FFHS&J at FFHS&J's hourly rates charged for services of this type and to be reimbursed for actual and

On the Petition Date, the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases were consolidated for administrative purposes only.

necessary out-of-pocket expenses incurred, subject to application to this Court in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, all applicable local rules, and orders of this Court.

On September 9, 2003, the Bankruptcy Court confirmed the Holding
 Company Debtors' Sixth Amended Plan of Reorganization (the "Plan") and on September 10,
 2003, the Holding Company Debtors consummated the Plan.

Previous Applications for Compensation and Expenses in these Chapter 11 Cases³

- On April 2, 2003, FFHS&J submitted an application to this Court for interim compensation and expenses incurred in the month of January in the amount of \$933,332.49.
- 6. On May 12, 2003, FFHS&J submitted an application to this Court for interim compensation and expenses incurred in the month of February in the amount of \$762,861.53.
- 7. On June 23, 2003, FFHS&J submitted an application to this Court for interim compensation and expenses incurred in the month of March in the amount of \$1,020,812.60.
- 8. On June 30, 2003, FFHS&J submitted an application to this Court for interim compensation and expenses incurred in the month of April in the amount of \$787,718.63, and an application for interim compensation and expenses incurred in the month of May in the amount of \$913,382.95.

In accordance with the Interim Compensation Order, the monthly fee applications filed by FFIIS&J only requested 90% of the total fees incurred during each month. FFIIS&J requested the remaining "held back" 10% from each month through May in its quarterly fee application, filed on August 19, 2003.

9. Concurrently with the filing of this Application, FFHS&J is submitting an application for interim compensation and expenses incurred in the month of July in the amount of \$534,027.63.

Fees

- its legal services on an hourly basis in accordance with its ordinary and customary rates for Bankruptcy Court authorized engagements in effect on the date the services are rendered, and submits that such rates are reasonable. In the normal course of business, FFIIS&J revises its hourly rates from time to time. FFHS&J's hourly rates for professional services rendered by bankruptcy and restructuring partners, "of counsel," and "special counsel" in non-Bankruptcy Court authorized and approved engagements are higher than the hourly rates charged by such professionals in connection with section 1103 engagements. The hourly rates for partners, "of counsel," and "special counsel" who are not bankruptcy and restructuring professionals are not so adjusted. FFHS&J's bankruptcy and restructuring associates and legal assistants have one hourly rate for all engagements. Because FFHS&J's fees: (a) are based on hourly rates and will correspond to the degree of effort expended on the Committee's behalf, and (b) are FFHS&J's usual and customary rates for services of this nature, FFHS&J believes that these rates are reasonable.
- 11. The FFHS&J attorneys who rendered professional services in these

- 13. In accordance with the factors enumerated in section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, FFHS&J believes that the amount of Fees and Expenses requested in this Application are fair and reasonable given the time expended, the complexity and size of the Chapter 11 Cases, the issues encountered and resolved, and the results obtained.
- 14. Exhibit A identifies the individuals that rendered services in each Subject Matter (as defined below), describes each activity or service that each individual performed, and states the number of hours (in increments of one-tenth of an hour) spent by each individual providing the services. Each numbered tab in Exhibit Λ corresponds to the matter number that FFHS&J assigned to the Subject Matter. If a Subject Matter does not appear, FFHS&J did not bill time or expenses for that Subject Matter during the Sixth Monthly Fee Period.

Subject Matters

15. The professional services that FFHS&J rendered during the Sixth Monthly Fee Period are grouped into the numbered and titled categories of the subject matters (the "Subject Matters") described in Paragraphs 16 through 24.

16. Matter 3: Employment Matters (Fees: \$40,196.00 Hours: 91.30)

This Subject Matter describes time spent in the negotiation, preparation, and review of all key executive employment agreements, including the employment agreement for the new Chairman of the Board of Directors. In addition, this Subject Matter describes time spent in discussions, analysis, and review of mattes and issues relating to Gary Wendt's employment and various pleadings related thereto. Further, this Subject Matter describes time spent negotiating and otherwise assisting the Committee in retaining an advisory firm to conduct background checks of potential candidates for the new board of directors of the reorganized Debtors. This Subject Matter also includes time spent researching, and working with the advisory firm and the Committee, on issues relating to the formation of a new board of directors for the reorganized Debtors.

17. <u>Matter 4: Tax Planning (Fees: \$84,012.50; Hours: \$184.50)</u>

This Subject Matter includes time spent reviewing, analyzing, discussing, and researching the tax issues related to the Debtors' restructuring, tax planning, and sale of CFC assets, and the implications thereof. In addition, this Subject Matter describes time spent reviewing and commenting on the tax aspects of the Debtors' reorganization. This Subject Matter also includes the review of any and all pleadings filed in the Chapter 11 Cases that concern tax-related issues.

18. <u>Matter 5: Plan and Disclosure Statement (Fees: \$264,571.00; Hours: 538.60)</u>

The Holding Company Debtors' hearing to confirm its Plan (the "Confirmation Hearing") commenced on June 13, 2003. In preparation for the Confirmation Hearing, FFHS&J worked with the Holding Company Debtors with regard to the objections to confirmation asserted by the Official Committee of Trust Originated Preferred Securities (the "TOPrS

Committee"). In addition, lawyers from FFHS&J attended the confirmation hearing, assisting the Holding Company Debtors, and ensuring that the rights of all unsecured creditors were benefited by the proceedings therein. This Subject Matter includes time spent updating and advising the Committee on the status of the Confirmation Hearing and the issues therein.

This Subject Matter also includes time spent analyzing, reviewing, and negotiating any and all revisions and open issues with respect to the Plan and the Plan Supplement, including, among other things, the Plan's release and indemnity provisions. In addition, this Subject Matter includes time spent reviewing, analyzing, and responding to objections to the Plan, as well as discussing the same with the Holding Company Debtors, and preparing a statement in support of the Plan. Finally, this Subject Matter describes time spent reviewing, analyzing, and discussing the various pleadings, motions, statements, and briefs filed in these Chapter 11 Cases and with respect to the Confirmation Hearing.

19. <u>Matter 6: CFC (Fees: \$43,736.50; Hours: 108.30)</u>

This Subject Matter includes time spent reviewing and negotiating revisions and objections to the CFC Debtors' plan of reorganization and the CFC Debtors' proposed confirmation order. In that regard, this Subject Matter also describes time spent analyzing various intercompany issues between the CFC Debtors and the Holding Company Debtors, including among other things, reviewing, analyzing, discussing and negotiating the settlement of intercompany claims between the Holding Company Debtors and the CFC Debtors. This Subject Matter also includes time spent attending the CFC Debtors' Confirmation Hearing and advising the Committee with respect thereto. Finally, this Subject Matter includes time spent reviewing pleadings regarding CFC, and reviewing, analyzing, and discussing issues related thereto.

20. <u>Matter 8: General Official Committee Matters (Fees: \$8,215.50;</u> Hours: 14.40)

This Subject Matter describes time spent by various FFHS&J lawyers in their communication with the Committee and its individual members, responding to their questions and providing them with updates with respect to these Chapter 11 Cases. Additionally, this Subject Matter describes time spent researching, preparing, revising, and discussing general issues related to the Chapter 11 Cases that do not fall into the more specific categories set forth in this Application.

21. <u>Matter 9: Litigation Matters (Fees: \$72,300.00; Hours: 279.20)</u>

This Subject Matter includes time spent preparing for and attending or participating in various Bankruptcy Court hearings related to the Debtors' restructuring. In preparation for the various hearings conducted by this Court, this Subject Matter includes time spent reviewing, analyzing, discussing, and responding to various pleadings and other Bankruptcy Court filings related to the Debtors' restructuring. This Subject Matter also includes time spent attending various proceedings and reviewing and analyzing pleadings related to the Holding Company Debtors' interest in the GM Building.

22. Matter 10: Communications with Non-Committee Creditors (Fees: \$4,611.50; Hours: 11.70)

This Subject Matter includes time spent discussing the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases' status with and responding to inquiries regarding the Debtors' restructuring from various creditors who are not members of the Committee.

23. Matter 11: Regulatory Matters (Fees: \$23,942.50; Hours: 51.70)

This Subject Matter includes time spent participating in weekly conference calls with respect to insurance subsidiary and regulatory issues with the Debtors and communication

with the Committee regarding the same. In addition, this Subject Matter includes time spent researching, analyzing, and addressing various regulatory and insurance rating issues that arose from time to time. Finally, this Subject Matter includes time spent working and communicating with special regulatory counsel in connection with the required regulatory filings to be made by Committee members as part of the Debtors' restructuring.

24. <u>Matter 12</u>: Fee Application (Fees: \$48,478.00; Hours: 183.20)

This Subject Matter includes time spent preparing, revising, reviewing, and discussing fee applications submitted to this Court for FFHS&J's fees and expenses associated with these Chapter 11 Cases, as well as coordinating the filing of a Certificate of No Objection to each fee application.

Professional Services Rendered

25. Subject to this Court's approval, FFHS&J has charged the Committee for its legal services on an hourly basis in accordance with its ordinary and customary rates for Bankruptcy Court authorized engagements in effect on the date the services are rendered, and submits that such rates are reasonable. In the normal course of business, FFHS&J revises its hourly rates from time to time. FFHS&J's hourly rates for professional services rendered by bankruptcy and restructuring partners, "of counsel," and "special counsel" in non-Bankruptcy Court authorized and approved engagements are higher than the hourly rates charged by such professionals in connection with Bankruptcy Code section 1103 engagements. The hourly rates for partners, "of counsel," and "special counsel" who are not bankruptcy and restructuring professionals are not so adjusted. FFHS&J's bankruptcy and restructuring associates and legal assistants have one hourly rate for all engagements. Because FTHS&J's fees: (a) are based on hourly rates and have corresponded and will continue to correspond to the degree of effort

expended on the Committee's behalf, and (b) are FFHS&J's usual and customary rates for services of this nature, FFHS&J believes that these rates are reasonable.

- 26. Often times it is necessary for more than one FFHS&J professional to attend a hearing, meeting, or conference call. FFIIS&J makes every effort to ensure that each and every individual who attends such activity is necessary and provides a benefit to the estate. FFHS&J senior professionals who attend such sessions do not merely passively supervise the junior professionals' work, nor do junior professionals bill the estate for time dedicated to observing a senior professionals' review of the junior associates' work product. While FFHS&J does not believe that the amount of time billed in this Application for intra-office conferences, "meet and confer time", multiple attendees at hearings, meetings, depositions, or conferences is more than 5% of FFHS&J's fees contained in this Application, it is FFHS&J's position that to the extent such time does exceed 5%, it is beneficial to the estate and should be reimbursed in full. Of course, FFHS&J does not bill the estate for professional or para-professional time spent carrying out clerical tasks, such as scheduling, making travel arrangements, or faxing.
- 27. In accordance with the factors enumerated in section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, FFHS&J believes that the amount of Fees and Expenses requested in this Application are fair and reasonable given the time expended, the complexity and size of the Chapter 11 Cases, the issues encountered and resolved, and the results obtained.

Actual and Necessary Expenses

28. FFHS&J customarily charges its clients for all ancillary services incurred, including photocopying charges, long distance telephone calls, facsimile transmissions, messengers, courier mail, computer and data bank time, word processing, secretarial overtime and temporary employees, overtime meals, overtime and late night transportation, travel,

lodging, meal charges for business meetings, postage, printing, transcripts, filing fees, document retrieval, and similar items. Subject to this Court's approval, FFHS&J requests reimbursement of all such charges incurred on behalf of the Committee.

- The time constraints frequently imposed by the circumstances of these 29. Chapter 11 Cases required FFHS&J attorneys and other employees to devote substantial amounts of time during evenings and weekends to providing professional services on the Committee's behalf. In virtually every instance, these extraordinary services were essential to meet deadlines imposed by the Court, the Bankruptcy Code, and at times, the necessities of the Debtors' businesses, the administration of the estates, or critical litigation. As a consequence, FFHS&J was required to incur overtime secretarial charges to discharge its professional responsibilities. FFHS&J attempts to reduce overtime secretarial charges and to limit them to necessary instances by encouraging its attorneys to use a secretarial "mini-center." If a secretary is not needed at the attorney's desk for the entire evening, the attorney is required to bring his or her work to a cluster of secretaries. The client is only charged for the word processing charges associated with the document, rather than charging the client for an evening of secretarial overtime, whether or not such secretary was used for the entire time. Similarly, overtime charges of administrative employees, such as research and document specialists, were incurred when necessary to discharge FFIIS&J's professional responsibilities and provide the most cost-effective legal services to the Committee.
- 30. FFHS&J's attorneys and other employees who work late into the evenings are reimbursed for their reasonable meal costs and their costs for transportation home. Such transportation costs are necessary expenses because it is FFHS&J's policy to ensure safe transportation for its attorneys during the hours that public transportation cannot be deemed safe.

In light of FFHS&J's location at the southern tip of Manhattan, it is often times very difficult to find a taxi cab late in the evening, and as such, FFHS&J provides for its attorneys and employees to make use of a private car service. The cost of private car rides, while greater than the cost of a taxicab ride, is a necessary and beneficial expense to the estate, as it allows FFHS&J attorneys the ability to stay late in the evening hours to complete necessary tasks without the apprehension of worrying about finding quick, reliable, and safe transportation home in the evening. It is FFHS&J's regular practice to charge its clients for these and other out-of-pocket expenses incurred during the rendition of professional services on the client's behalf.

- page for outgoing telecopier transmissions (plus related toll charges). FFHS&J does not charge its clients for incoming telecopier transmissions. FFHS&J has negotiated a discounted rate for Westlaw computer assisted legal research, which is approximately \$125/hour of online use of the standard Westlaw databases. Computer assisted legal research is used whenever the researcher determines that using Westlaw is more cost effective than using traditional (non-computer assisted legal research) techniques. In addition, because certain key parties to these Chapter 11 Cases are located outside of New York, FFHS&J incurred long distance telephone charges, and when necessary, overnight delivery charges. FFHS&J made every effort to minimize such disbursements by using electronic mail and facsimile when possible. The expenses incurred in the rendition of professional services were necessary, reasonable, and justified under the circumstances and enabled FFHS&J to serve the needs of the Committee to the benefit of all creditors.
- 32. Exhibit B is a detailed itemization and description of the disbursements made by FFHS&J on the Committee's behalf during the Sixth Monthly Fee Period. All of these

disbursements comprise the requested sum for FFHS&J's Expenses, totaling \$65,939.30. The following is a list of FFHS&J's Expenses, grouped by type of Expense:

Although every effort has been made to include all Fees and Expenses incurred in the Sixth Monthly Fee Period in this Application, some Fees and Expenses might not be included in this Application due to delays caused by accounting processing procedures. FFHS&J reserves the right to make further application to this Court for allowance of such Fees and Expenses not included herein. In addition, certain Fees and Expenses incurred during the previous fee periods that were not included in the previous fee applications have been included in this Application. Subsequent fee applications will be filed in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, Local Bankruptcy Rules, and the Interim Compensation Order.

In accordance with the position of the U.S. Trustee set forth at the Committee Formation Meeting, charges for air travel are charged at the highest coach class rate on the day of travel. In addition, non-working travel time is charged at one half the time actually spent traveling. These adjustments have led to FFIIS&J reducing this Application by \$11,789.52.

In accordance with the position of the U.S. Trustee set forth at the Committee Formation Meeting, charges for hotel accommodations have been capped at \$250 per night in Chicago. These adjustments have led to FFHS&J reducing the Expenses requested by this Application by \$45.00.

WHEREFORE, FFHS&J requests that it be allowed and paid interim compensation for its Fees and Expenses in the total amount of \$596,996.45 consisting of (a) \$531,057.15, which is 90% of the Fees for reasonable and necessary professional services rendered by FFHS&J in the amount of \$590,063.50, and (b) \$65,939.30 for actual and necessary Expenses incurred on behalf of the Committee. FFHS&J further requests that the total amount of \$596,996.45 be paid as an administrative expense of the estates.
