STINSON MORRISON HECKER LLP'S FOURTH AND FINAL APPLICATION FOR AWARD OF COMPENSATION FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED

TO: THE HONORABLE ADLAI S. HARDIN, JR. UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY JUDGE

Stinson Morrison Hecker LLP ("SMH"), counsel for the Official Section 1114 Committee of Retired Pilots (the "Retired Pilots Committee"), applies for fourth and final allowance of compensation for professional services and reimbursement of expenses performed by SMH in connection with the above captioned bankruptcy cases (the "Application") as follows:

- a) Allowance of compensation for professional services for the period of February 1, 2007, through March 31, 2007 (the "Application Period") in the total amount of \$216,338.50;
- b) allowance of its actual and necessary expenses incurred during the Application Period in the total amount of \$11,404.77;
- c) payment of the 20% holdback withheld from SMH's Fee Statements for the periods of February 1, 2007 through March 31, 2007 (the "Monthly Fee Statements"); and
- d) SMH further requests final approval of all fees and costs previously approved on an interim basis from March 30, 2006 through January 31, 2007, in the amount of \$1,136,253.50 in fees and \$82,348.27 in expenses.

SMH files this Application pursuant to Sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), Rule 2016(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), and the Order Pursuant to Sections 105(a) and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 2016(a) to Establish Procedures for Interim Monthly Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals, dated October 6, 2005 (the "Compensation and Reimbursement Order"). The amount sought for fees for the Application Period represents 651.70 hours of professional services. In support of this Application, SMH shows the Court the following:

JURISDICTION

1. The Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2). Venue of this case is proper in this district pursuant to

28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409, respectively. This Application requests relief pursuant to Sections 330, 331, 1103 and 1114 of the Bankruptcy Code.

BACKGROUND

- 2. On September 14, 2005 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of Bankruptcy Code.
- 3. On October 6, 2005, this Court entered the Compensation and Reimbursement Order. The Compensation and Reimbursement Order authorized professionals paid from the Debtors' bankruptcy estates to serve monthly fee statements, by hand or overnight delivery, seeking payment for services rendered and for out-of-pocket expenses or other charges incurred on or before the 20th day of each month following the month for which compensation is sought on (i) Delta Air Lines, Inc.; (ii) counsel for the Debtors, Davis Polk & Wardwell; (iii) counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors, Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP; (iv) counsel to the Official Section 1114 Committee, Foley & Lardner; (v) the Office of the United States Trustee for the Southern District of New York; (vi) counsel for the Official Section 1114 Committee of Retired Pilots; and (vii) counsel for any other official committee appointed by the Court. The Compensation and Reimbursement Order authorized the Debtors to pay professionals 80% of fees requested and 100% of expenses identified in each Monthly Fee Statement.
- 4. On March 17, 2006, this Court entered an Order approving the report of the United States Trustee regarding the solicitation process for forming an official committee to represent the retired pilot employees of the Debtors, and their spouses and dependents (the "Retired Pilots"). The Retired Pilots Committee consisted of nine members until it was dissolved by operation of the Bankruptcy Code on Debtors' Effective Date, April 30, 2007. The

Retired Pilots Committee selected SMH to serve as its lead counsel, and the law firm of Wilson Elser Moskowitz Edelman & Dicker LLP ("Wilson Elser") to serve as local co-counsel to represent the interest of the Retired Pilots Committee and its constituent members pursuant to section 1114 of the Bankruptcy Code.

- 5. On May 1, 2006, this Court entered an Order Authorizing the Employment and Retention of SMH and Wilson Elser as Attorneys to the Retired Pilots Committee Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1114.
- 6. On July 13, 2006, SMH submitted Stinson Morrison Hecker LLP's First Application for Award of Compensation for Professional Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred ("SMH's First Application") for the time period from March 30, 2006, through May 31, 2006 (DE #2852). In due course, pursuant to the Compensation and Reimbursement Order, SMH's monthly statements for March through May 2006 had been paid at 80% of fees and 100% of costs, totaling \$254,335.96. SMH's First Application was approved and payment of the balance of 20% of fees was approved by this Court's Order of August 21, 2006.
- 7. On November 10, 2006, SMH submitted Stinson Morrison Hecker LLP's Second Application for Award of Compensation for Professional Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred ("SMH's Second Application") for the time period from June 1, 2006, through September 30, 2006 (DE #3547). In due course, pursuant to the Compensation and Reimbursement Order, SMH's monthly statements for June, July, August, and September 2006 had been paid at 80% of fees and 100% of costs, totaling \$378,862.56. SMH's Second Application was approved and payment of the balance of 20% of fees was approved by this Court's Order of December 18, 2006.

- 8. On March 16, 2007, SMH submitted Stinson Morrison Hecker LLP's Third Application for Award of Compensation for Professional Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred ("SMH's Third Application") for the time period from October 1, 2006, through January 31, 2007 (DE #5238). In due course, pursuant to the Compensation and Reimbursement Order, SMH's monthly statements for October 2006 through January 2007 had been paid at 80% of fees and 100% of costs, totaling \$356,417.90. SMH's Third Application was approved and payment of the balance of 20% of fees was approved by this Court's order dated April 19, 2007, which payment was made on or about April 27, 2007.
- 9. The total compensation awarded on an interim basis pursuant to the First, Second, and Third Applications (which are incorporated herein by this reference) was \$1,136,253.50 in fees and \$82,348.27 in expenses.
- 10. On April 25, 2007, the Court entered its Order confirming Debtors' Plan herein (DE #5998). The plan was substantially consummated on April 30, 2007.

OVERVIEW OF COMPENSATION SOUGHT

11. SMH served its Monthly Fee Statements in accordance with the Compensation and Reimbursement Order and no objections were filed. During the current period of February 1, 2007, through March 31, 2007, SMH incurred a total of \$216,388.50 in fees and \$11,404.77 in expenses. In accordance with the Compensation and Reimbursement Order, SMH has received \$115,088.40 in fees and \$9,395.32 in expenses to date for the period from February 1, 2007, through March 31, 2007. There remain outstanding 20% of fees of \$28,772.10 for February, plus 100% of fees of \$72,528.00 and 100% of costs of \$2,009.45, for March 2007, resulting in total payable fees of \$101,300.10, and 100% of costs of \$2,009.45, for February and March 2007. The objection deadline for the March fees was May 7, 2007. This

Application seeks final approval of all fees and expenses incurred from February to March 2007, plus final approval of all interim fees and costs previously approved for SMH from March 30, 2006, through January 31, 2007, and payment of the balance of those approved fees and expenses, currently \$72,528.00 in fees and \$2,009.45 in expenses for March 2007, plus the outstanding holdback funds of \$28,772.10 in fees for February 2007.

SMH'S APPLICATION

12. In accordance with Sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 2016, and the Compensation and Reimbursement Order, SMH seeks: (i) allowance of compensation for professional services performed by SMH during the Application Period in the total amount of \$216,388.50; (ii) allowance of its actual and necessary expenses incurred during the Application Period in the amount of \$11,404.77; (iii) final approval of all fees and costs previously approved on an interim basis; and (iv) payment of the unpaid balance of its fees and expenses for the Application Period, including, but not limited to, the 20% holdback withheld from the Monthly Fee Statements.

13. Under Section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Court may allow compensation and reimbursement of SMH's expenses only after notice and a hearing. Bankruptcy Rule 2002(a)(6) provides that hearings on applications for compensation and reimbursement of expenses totaling in excess of \$1,000 must be on 20-days notice to parties in interest. Section 331 of the Bankruptcy Code authorizes the filing of interim fee applications. This Application is the third such application made by SMH under Section 331 of the Bankruptcy Code. The total fees for services rendered to the Retired Pilots Committee during the Application Period are \$216,388.50 and the necessary expenses incurred during this period are \$11,404.77.

14. This Application complies with the Amended Guidelines for Fees and Disbursements of Professionals in the Southern District of New York Bankruptcy Cases, adopted by the court on April 19, 1995 (the "Local Guidelines"), the United Trustee Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed under 11 U.S.C. § 330, adopted on January 30, 1996 (the "UST Guidelines"), and the Compensation Order. A certification of compliance with the Local and UST Guidelines and Compensation Order is attached as Exhibit "A."

15. All legal services performed by SMH were performed for and solely on behalf of the Retired Pilots Committee, and not on behalf of any other committee, creditor, or other person or entity.

16. The following is a brief summary of the qualifications of each SMH professional representing the Debtors for which compensation is sought:

Attorneys:

- C. Taylor Ashworth: Taylor Ashworth is a partner with the law firm of SMH, practicing since 1971, who has experience in bankruptcy matters.
- Alisa C. Lacey: Alisa Lacey is a partner with the law firm of SMH, practicing since 1986, who has experience in bankruptcy matters.
- <u>Christopher Graver:</u> Chris Graver is of counsel to the law firm of SMH, practicing since 1990, who has experience in bankruptcy matters.
- Robert A. West: Robert West is a partner with the law firm of SMH, practicing since 1988, who has experience in employee benefit matters.
- Warren J. Stapleton: Warren Stapleton is a partner with the law firm of SMH, practicing since 1997, who has experience in bankruptcy matters.
- Morris J. Nunn: Morris Nunn is a partner with the law firm of SMH, practicing since 1970, who has experience in employee benefit matters.
- Theodore M. Mitchell: Theodore Mitchell is an associate with the law firm of SMH, practicing since 2005, who has experience in employee benefit matters.

SUMMARY OF SERVICES RENDERED

During this Application Period, SMH has expended a total of 651.70 hours in representing the retired pilots committee, of a value of \$216,388.50, and has incurred costs of \$11,404.77, for a total of \$227,793.27. The services and costs for which approval is sought were actually incurred, necessary, and SMH believes the amount of compensation and reimbursement requested is reasonable.

SMH segregates its time into billing categories in accordance with the applicable U.S. Trustee Guidelines. **Exhibit "B"** hereto provides a breakdown of the fees requested by SMH by project category.

A. Case administration

During the application period, SMH spent a total of 2.10 hours on matters related to case administration, including communications with client, attorneys, and actuaries, supervise website postings, review of various ECF filings for applicability to Retired Pilot Committee, administrative document review, and case management matters for a total of \$642.00.

enrollment rights and assertion of claims for lost medical benefits under the settlement, filings in Bankruptcy Court, and other matters related to the services described elsewhere in this Application, for a total of \$36,250.00.

- 17. The foregoing professional services performed by SMH for which compensation is requested were rendered on behalf of the Committee and compensation is sought pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330(a), 331, and 503(a) and (b), and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2016(a). The Fee Application complies with the Order approving employment of SMH, the Compensation and Reimbursement Order, the Local Guidelines, and the UST Guidelines.
- 18. The names of all of SMH's professionals and paraprofessionals requesting fees, the hourly rates charged by each, and the hours worked by each during the Application Period are provided in the Summary attached hereto as Exhibit "C." The rates charged by the professionals in this case are ordinary and comparable to rates charged to non-bankruptcy clients.
- 19. The professional services provided by SMH on behalf of the Retired Pilots Committee during the Application Period required an aggregate expenditure of 651.70 recorded hours by SMH's members, counsel, associates and paraprofessionals. Of the aggregate time expended, 599.00 recorded hours were expended by partners and counsel of SMH, 28.50 recorded hours were expended by associates, and 24.20 recorded hours were expended by paraprofessionals of SMH.
- 20. During the Application Period, SMH's hourly billing rates for attorneys ranged from \$160.00 to \$450.00 per hour. As noted, attached hereto is a schedule listing each SMH professional and paraprofessional who performed services in these cases during the Application Period, the hourly rate charged for their services, and the aggregate number of hours charged by each such individual.

FINAL APPROVAL

21. This Application includes a request for final approval of all its fees and costs, including those previously awarded on an interim basis, as described in paragraph 30 below.

STATUTORY BASIS FOR COMPENSATION

22. Sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code form the statutory basis for compensation of professionals in bankruptcy cases. Section 330 provides that a court may award a professional employed under Section 327 of the Bankruptcy Code "reasonable compensation for actual, necessary services rendered ... and reimbursement for actual, necessary expenses." 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(1). Section 330 also sets forth the criteria for the award of such compensation and reimbursement.

In determining the amount of reasonable compensation to be awarded, the court shall consider the nature, the extent, and the value of such services, taking into account all relevant factors including—

- (A) the time spent on such services;
- (B) the rates charged for such services;
- (C) whether the services were necessary to the administration of, or beneficial at the time at which the service was rendered toward the completion of, a case under this title;
- (D) whether the services were performed within a reasonable amount of time commensurate with the complexity, importance and nature of the problem, issue, or task addressed; and
- (E) whether the compensation is reasonable based on the customary compensations charged by comparatively skilled practitioners in cases other than cases under this title.

11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(3). Pursuant to Section 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Court may authorize interim compensation for professional services. 11 U.S.C. § 331.

23. The Bankruptcy Code provisions concerning the compensation of professionals are designed to ensure that qualified attorneys will be compensated for services rendered to the debtors at a market rate for comparable services rendered in non-bankruptcy cases. <u>In re Ames Dep't Stores</u>, <u>Inc.</u>, 76 F.3d 66, 71 (2d Cir. 1996). The rationale behind this

goal is to ensure that counsel will not be deterred from taking bankruptcy cases due to failure to pay adequate compensation.

24. SMH has rendered substantial and valuable services on behalf of the Retired Pilots Committee that have resulted in a significant benefit to the Debtors' estate, and its creditors, and which were beneficial to the administration of the chapter 11 case. SMH respectfully submits that its services were provided with the requisite level of skill and were performed within a reasonable amount of time commensurate with the complexity, importance, and nature of problems, issues, and tasks addressed. SMH has charged its customary fees, which are reasonable based on the customary compensation charged by comparably skilled practitioners in cases other than cases under this title. The amount sought in compensation is in line with awards in similar cases and is commensurate with the professional standing, ability and expertise of SMH and the professionals who have participated in this case. Accordingly, the compensation requested herein reflects the reasonable value of the services provided to the Retired Pilots Committee.

25. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "D"** are statements of the fees that SMH actually charged during the Application Period, corresponding to the categories detailed above. In accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 2016(a), the itemized list identifies: (a) the specific tasks performed; (b) the attorney who performed them; (c) the time required to perform them; (d) the date on which the tasks were performed. To the extent possible, SMH has described each specific task and separately allocated the time attributable to that task. Where the nature of certain tasks and the circumstances surrounding their performance did not allow for individual time entries, aggregate time entries were used.

REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

26. Pursuant to § 330(a)(1)(B) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Court may award a professional "reimbursement for actual, necessary expenses." 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(1)(B). Accordingly, SMH seeks reimbursement of the actual, necessary expenses that it incurred during the course of providing legal services to the Retired Pilots Committee. SMH typically charges its clients \$0.20 per page for copies. Charges for travel, overnight delivery, postage, long distance phone calls, and other out-of-pocket disbursements are based on actual amounts paid by SMH for those services. A detailed description of expenses that SMH incurred during the Application Period is included on the attached Exhibit "D."

In addition, because of the location of the Debtors, and of the majority of members of the Retired Pilots Committee, frequent long distance telephone calls were required. On several occasions, overnight delivery of documents and other materials was required as a result of circumstances necessitating the use of such express services. These expenses are not included in SMH's overhead for the purpose of setting billing rates. SMH made efforts to minimize its expenses in these cases. The actual expenses incurred in providing professional services to the Retired Pilots Committee were necessary, reasonable, and justified under the circumstances to serve the needs of the Retired Pilots Committee.

MEMORANDUM OF LAW

27. Because this Application presents no novel issues of law and the authorities relied upon by the Retired Pilots 1114 Committee are set forth herein, it is respectfully requested that the Court waive the requirement for the filing of a separate memorandum of law in support of this Application pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 9013-1(b).

No Prior Request

28. No prior request for the relief sought herein has been made to this or any other court.

CONCLUSION

29. As the attached exhibits demonstrate, SMH is entitled to allowance for the Application Period of compensation of \$216,388.50 for its professional services, and \$11,404.77 for actual and necessary expenses, and payment of such amount to the extent not already paid, pursuant to the Compensation and Reimbursement Order.

30. SMH is further entitled to final approval of its fees and costs previously approved and paid pursuant to its First, Second and Third Applications. The total amount of fees and costs for which final approval is sought is as follows:
