**ORDER APPROVING FINAL APPLICATION OF SPRIGGS & HOLLINGSWORTH AS  
SPECIAL COUNSEL FOR DEBTORS FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION FOR  
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RENDERED AND FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF  
ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED  
FROM NOVEMBER 19, 2002 THROUGH JUNE 9, 2003**

Upon consideration of the application (the "Application") of Spriggs & Hollingsworth for an order Approving the Final Application of Spriggs & Hollingsworth as Special Counsel for Debtors for Allowance of Compensation for Professional Services Rendered and for Reimbursement of Actual and Necessary Expenses Incurred from November 19, 2002 through June 9, 2003 and the Court being satisfied that the relief requested in the Application is in the best interests of the Debtors and their estates; and it appearing that due notice of this Application has been given and that no other or further notice be given and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is

ORDERED that the Application is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that Spriggs & Hollingsworth ("S&H") is entitled to a final allowance of \$220,658.49 for the period from November 19, 2002 through June 9, 2003 (the "Compensation Period"), representing \$166,563.50 as compensation for professional services



rendered during the Compensation Period and \$54,094.99 as reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses S&H incurred during the Compensation Period; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors are authorized to pay Spriggs & Hollingsworth such sums, to the extent that such amounts have not previously been paid; and it is further

ORDERED that Spriggs & Hollingsworth is entitled to seek compensation for preparation of its Application.
