FIRST AND FINAL APPLICATION OF PATCH INCORPORATED, PERMITTING CONSULTANTS FOR THE DEBTORS, FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FROM JULY, 2002 THROUGH AUGUST, 2002

TO THE HONORABLE ARTHUR J. GONZALEZ CHIEF UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY JUDGE:

Patch Incorporated, Permitting Consultant for Enron Corp., et al., (the "Debtors") appointed in the Chapter 11 case of the Debtors submits this first and final application (the "Application"), pursuant to Sections 328, 330(a) and 331 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") and Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), for the allowance of compensation for professional services rendered for the period May, 2002 through August, 2002 and for reimbursement of expenses incurred in connection with such services, and, in support thereof, respectfully represents:

Summary of Application

1. Patch Incorporated seeks allowance of compensation for professional services rendered to the Debtors for the period July, 2002 through August, 2002 (the "Compensation Period") in the aggregate amount of \$29,468.39 and for reimbursement of expenses incurred in the aggregate amount of \$4,763.83. During the Compensation Period, Patch professionals expended a total of 299 hours for which compensation is requested. This Application is considered to be Patch's first and final application for compensation, because the Roseville, CA power project for which services were rendered has been made inactive as of the end of July, 2002.

2. Patch's invoices # 033A (dated 7/25/02), # 034 (dated 8/07/02), itemize the services rendered during the Compensation Period. Patch's invoices are is attached hereto; all rates for Patch personnel are discounted from Patch's standard charges.

3. In preparing this Application, Patch has complied with the Amended Guidelines for Fees and Disbursements for Professionals in Southern District of New York Bankruptcy Cases adopted by the Court on April 19, 1995 (the "Local Guideline"), the United States Trustee Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses filed under 11 U.S.C. 330 adopted January 30, 1996 (the "UST Guidelines"), and the Court's Order Pursuant to Title 11 U.S.C. Sections 105(a) and 331 Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Professionals dated January 17, 2002 as supplemented on April 26, 2002 (the "Administrative Order" and collectively with the Local Guidelines, and the UST Guidelines, the "Guidelines"). Patch believes that all applicable fee and disbursement charges for the Compensation Period have been included herein. However, to the extent expenses were incurred in connection with services rendered during the Compensation

Period, but were not presented and processed prior to the preparation of this Application, Patch reserves the right to request reimbursement of such expenses in a future application.

Jurisdiction and Venue

4. The Court has jurisdiction to consider the Application pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. Sections 157 and 1334. Venue is proper before this Court pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. Sections 1408 and 1409.

Background

5. On December 2, 2001, the Debtors filed the first of several voluntary petitions under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.

6. On February 22, 2002, the Court issued an **Order Pursuant to Section 327 of the Bankruptcy Code authorizing** *Nunc Pro Tunc* **Employment of Professionals Utilized in the Ordinary Course of Business.** Patch Incorporated was included as an "ordinary course professional" in the Court's Order of February 22, 2002. The Court's Order of February 22, 2002, authorized \$50,000/month on average over a twelve month period; the sums for which reimbursement is sought herein represent fees and expenses incurred in excess of the aforesaid amount for additional work authorized by Debtors' representatives for permitting and related services for the Roseville Energy Facility (REF), an asset of the Debtors' estate which has been delayed and that the Roseville project is presently inactive and Patch's work has been terminated.

Services Rendered by Patch during the Compensation Period

7. Patch has provided since December, 2001 multi-disciplinary engineering, field construction and technical services in support of generating emission reduction credits,

assessments, a revised project description and technical services in support of Enron obtaining the required licenses and permits (federal, state and local) to build and operate the proposed Roseville Energy Facility (REF). Those services involve overall project management, technical engineering, field construction and other related services requested by Enron.

Project Management

8. Patch's engineering and technical services include ongoing coordination and consultation with Enron, the REF environmental consultant (URS), the City of Roseville, owners and developers of adjacent properties, and federal and state regulatory agency representatives to ascertain the appropriate level of effort to keep the project permitting/licensing efforts on schedule. The engineering and technical services also included management of the Patch project team (including subcontractors) in order to meet the stipulated California Energy Commission (CEC) Order dated May 9, 2002 report deliverable deadline of July 1, 2002 for Response to Outstanding Data Requests 1 – 192 including associated technical reports and documents. Waiver of Memorandum of Law.

<u>Mapping</u>

9. Patch mapping services included field reconnaissance to identify primary and alternate routes and development of project base maps (topographic and aerial photo based) to depict the approximately 50 miles of new natural gas pipeline routes plus 50 miles of 230 kV electrical transmission line routes which were added at Enron's request. The mapping effort also included identification of property owners and development of notification maps to meet California Energy Commission (CEC) requirements.

Air Quality

10. Patch air quality services included preparation of ongoing responses to air quality data requests from the CEC and estimates of types and quantities of construction equipment, manpower and truck deliveries to be used in URS' environmental assessment of construction emission impacts due to the addition of approximately 100 combined miles of new gas and transmission line routes. The air quality services also included÷the review and comment on the Preliminary Determination of Compliance issued by the Placer County APCD in compliance with PCAPCD's stipulated 30 day public comment period ending in mid August 2002.

Agricultural Pump Program

11 Patch provided engineering, procurement, installation and maintenance services, at Enron's request, for the agricultural pump program intended to develop emission reduction credits for the REF project in Yolo County and/or for transfer to Placer County. This program was additional work scope beginning in March 2001, and accounts for \$235,634.31 of the total \$534,232.22 fees and expenses incurred since December 2, 2001.

Water Resources

12. Patch water resources related services consisted primarily of responding to over 50 detailed Water Resources related questions in Response to the CEC's Outstanding Data Requests 1 - 192, meetings with the City of Roseville to resolve water supply issues and performing additional engineering calculations to confirm the supply capability of the Pleasant Grove Waste Water Treatment Facility, the REF's water source.

<u>Traffic</u>

13. Patch traffic and transportation related services included identification of roadways potentially affected by the approximately 100 miles of new gas and transmission line routes, describing proposed crossing methods such as pipeline trench or bore or overhead transmission conductor crossing of highways, and estimating construction manpower and truck deliveries for use by URS in assessing project related environmental traffic impacts..

<u>Noise</u>

14. Patch noise related services consisted primarily of identification of expected equipment noise emissions and mitigation required and provided numerous equipment noise abatement alternatives to comply with noise standards and ordinances, and for use by URS in noise modeling and preparation of responses to CEC noise related data requests associated with potential power plant noise impacts on nearby sensitive receptors.

Visual Resources

15. Patch services consisted of field reconnaissance, photography and preparation of visual simulations of transmission line modifications on the Western Area Power Administration and Sacramento Municipal Utility District systems from multiple key observation points selected by URS to demonstrate pre- and post-project visual conditions..

Revised Project Description

16. Patch services at the request of the CEC and Enron included preparation of a revised Project Description of the approximately 100 miles of new gas and transmission line routes for use in the Response to Outstanding Data Requests 1 - 192 (July 1, 2002).

Waiver of Memorandum of Law

17.Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule for the Southern District of New York9013-1(b), because there are no novel issues of law presented by this Application, Patch respectfully requests that the Court waive the requirement that Patch file a memorandum of law in support of this Application.

WHEREFORE, Patch respectfully requests (a) allowance of compensation

for professional services rendered as Engineering and Technical consultants for the Debtors in the amount of \$29,468.39, (b) reimbursement of actual and necessary disbursements incurred in the amount of \$4,476.83, (c) such other and further relief as is just, and (d) authority for the Debtor to pay to Patch outstanding compensation and reimbursement of expenses in the aggregate amount of \$34,232.22.
