## SECOND AND FINAL APPLICATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 1, 1997 THROUGH MARCH 16, 1998

Pepper Hamilton LLP<sup>1</sup> ("Applicant"), co-counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors ("Committee") appointed in the captioned cases, states:

- 1. The Committee was appointed by Order of this Court dated July 28, 1997.
- 2. During the course of these proceedings, it was necessary for Committee members to travel to and attend meetings between the Committee and the Debtors' representatives and other parties in interest concerning matters that required investigation, negotiation and decision by the Committee. The Committee's plan negotiating subcommittee, consisting of James Graves, Joel Denney and Eric Grubelich, was actively involved in the negotiations which resulted in the excellent result for unsecured creditors in this case, and incurred significant travel and related expenses in connection therewith.

- The members of the Committee have incurred expenses in the aggregate amount of \$31,480.34 in the performance of their duties from November 1, 1997 through March 16.

  1998<sup>2</sup>. A summary of the expenses requested by each member is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

  Copies of invoices supporting the expense request submitted for this period are attached as a part of Exhibit A.
- 4. Attached as Exhibit B is a proposed Order approving reimbursement of the Committee members' expenses.
- 5. The expenses were incurred while the Committee was performing its functions in accordance with the Order appointing the Committee.
- 6. The expenses incurred by the Committee members were necessary to permit the effective performance of the Committee's fiduciary duties. Applicant requests Court approval of reimbursement of expenses incurred by the Committee members.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the expenses incurred by the members of the Creditors' Committee for such portions of the period November 1, 1997 through March 16, 1998 as are reflected on Exhibit A be approved in the total amount of \$31,480.34, and that any
