(a) On April 24, 2000, the Bankruptcy Court entered an order Employing E&Y Restructuring LLC ("EYR") as restructuring and reorganization accountants and financial advisors nunc pro tunc to October 1, 1999. On May 3, 2000, the Office of the United States Trustee filed a motion for reconsideration. The hearing on reconsideration has been adjourned to December 14, 2000. EYR changed its name to E&Y Capital Advisors LLC ("EYCA") effective October 1, 2000. Notice of the name change was served and filed on or about September 20, 2000.

(b) This amount includes charges of Mayer, Brown & Platt ("MBP") in the amount of \$110,518. MBP represents EYCA in connection with (i) discovery taken by Park Place Entertainment in connection with a plan confirmation, and (ii) the United States Trustee's motion for reconsideration and the discovery that has taken place in connection herewith. Copies of MBP's bills are included in Exhibit D.
