therein is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, and creditors; it appearing that proper and adequate notice of the Notice has been given and that no other or further notice is necessary; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. The fees and expenses requested in the Final Fee Applications are hereby approved and allowed on a final basis in the amounts set forth on Exhibit A attached to this order without prejudice to later allowance of requested expenses not approved hereby.

2. The Debtors are hereby authorized to promptly pay each Professional the difference, if any, between the allowed amount of fees and expenses approved by this Order and the actual interim payments received by each respective Professional.


3. Each Professional is authorized to setoff any amounts approved by this order against any postpetition retainer.

4. This Order is without prejudice to the rights of the Professionals to seek further allowance and

payment of compensation and reimbursement of expenses upon application to this Court.

5. This Order is a separate order for each Professional and the appeal of any order with respect to any Professional shall have no effect on the authorized fees and expenses of the other Professionals.
