FIRST AND FINAL APPLICATION OF ERNST & YOUNG LLP AS VALUATION SUPPORT SERVICE PROVIDER TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF EQUITY SECURITY HOLDERS OF IMPERIAL DISTRIBUTING FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR THE PERIOD FROM APRIL 1, 2001 THROUGH AUGUST 10, 2001

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§328, 330, 331 and 503(b) and Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and in accordance with U.S. Department of Justice, Executive Office for the United States Trustee's Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses filed under 11 U.S.C. section 330 (the "Guidelines") Ernst & Young LLP ("E&Y" or the "Applicant") hereby moves this Honorable Court for an Order awarding it reasonable compensation with respect to Imperial Distributing (the "Debtor") for Accounting and Litigation Support Services in the amount of \$195,710 together with reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the amount of \$4,240 for the period from April 1, 2001 through August 10, 2001 (the "First and Final Compensation Period"). In support of its First and Final Application, E&Y respectfully represents as follows:

- 1. On January 16, 2001 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").
- 2. E&Y was employed to represent the The Official Committee Of Equity Security Holders as of March 16, 2001.
- 3. E&Y has received no payment and no promises for payment from any source for services rendered or to be rendered in any capacity whatsoever in connection with the matters covered by this Application.
- 4. E&Y makes its First and Final Application for allowance of reasonable compensation for actual and necessary professional services of \$195,710 and out-of-pocket expenses of \$4,240 incurred by E&Y during the period from April 1, 2001 through August 10, 2001 (the "First and Final Compensation Period") as the Accounting and Litigation Support Service Provider to the Official Committee Of Equity Security Holders. The total amount E&Y requests payment of in the First and Final Application is \$199,950
- 5. In rendering the services described bellows, E&Y has expended a total of 637.1 hours. A summary of hours is attached as Exhibit A hereto incurred by each E&Y professional.

- 6. Pursuant to the agreement set forth in the E&Y Letter of Understanding and Order Authorizing the Employment and Retention of E&Y, E&Y is entitled to fees based on time incurred at hourly rates, and reimbursement of reasonable out of pocket expenses incurred in connection with providing Accounting and Litigation Support Services.
- 7. E&Y has presented the services rendered by Project Code Descriptions ("PCD"), identifying the activities within each category, naming each person who performed the activity, the number of hours spent by each person in tenths of an hour, and a description of the work performed. The services rendered are set forth in the statement of services summarized by PCD attached as **Exhibit B** to the Application.
- 8. In addition to the time expended as described in **Exhibit B**, E&Y has incurred expenses during the First and Final Compensation Period in the sum of \$4,240. These expenses represent actual and necessary costs and disbursements incurred on behalf of the Debtors. These expenses are described in **Exhibit C** attached hereto.
- 9. It is the Applicant's policy to review its time charges to ensure that they are consistent with the value provided to the estate and in compliance with the Guidelines.
- 10. Ernst & Young has not shared or agreed to share any of its compensation from the Debtors with any other person, other than as permitted under section 504 of the Bankruptcy Code.
