ORDER GRANTING AMENDED FINAL FEE APPLICATION OF STUART, MAUE, MITCHELL & JAMES, LTD., FEE AUDITOR, FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR THE PERIOD FROM APRIL 16, 2001 THROUGH FEBRUARY 4, 2004 REGARDING DOCKET NO. 3995

Upon consideration of the Amended Final Fee Application of Stuart, Maue, Mitchell & James, Ltd. ("Stuart Maue"), Fee Auditor, for allowance of compensation for services rendered in the amount of \$1,178,623.00 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$48,865.09 for the period from April 16, 2001 through February 4, 2004; the Court having reviewed the Amended Final Fee Application; and finding that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and after notice and opportunity for a hearing to consider the Amended Final Fee Application; and no objections having been filed to the relief requested; and upon the record and after due deliberation;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

- Stuart, Maue, Mitchell & James, Ltd. is allowed as final compensation for 1. services rendered the amount of \$1,178,623.00 and as reimbursement of expenses the amount of \$48,865.09 for the period from April 16, 2001 through February 4, 2004.
- All previous payments made to Stuart Maue as allowed interim fees and expenses 2. in accordance with the Compensation Order are hereby approved and allowed on a final basis.
- Debtors are authorized and directed to pay to Stuart Maue the amount of 3. \$1,178,623.00 as compensation for services rendered and \$48,865.09 as expense reimbursement for the period from April 16, 2001 through February 4, 2004, less any amounts previously paid by Debtors to Stuart Maue.
- This Court shall retain exclusive jurisdiction over any matter arising out of or 4. related to this Order or Amended Final Fee Application.
