**THIRD INTERIM AND FINAL APPLICATION
OF JONES DAY FOR COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES
RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR
THE PERIOD FROM FEBRUARY 23, 2004 THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2005**

Pursuant to (a) sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1330 (the "Bankruptcy Code"), (b) Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), (c) the Administrative Order, Pursuant to Sections 105(a) and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals (D.I. 225), entered on March 22, 2004 (the "Interim Compensation Order"); and (d) the Order Appointing Fee Auditor and Establishing Related Procedures Concerning the Allowance and Payment of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals and Members of Official Committees and Consideration of Fee Applications (D.I. 944), entered on May 28, 2004 (the "Fee Order"), Jones Day hereby files this Third Interim and Final Application of Jones Day for Compensation for Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period from February 23, 2004 through January 31, 2005 (the "Final Application"). By this Final Application, Jones Day seeks final allowance of compensation for services rendered to the above-captioned reorganized

debtors (collectively, the "Debtors") of \$6,392,348.75¹ and reimbursement of related expenses of \$345,913.75² for a total of \$6,738,262.50 for the period February 23, 2004 through January 31, 2005 (the "Compensation Period"). In support of this Final Application, Jones Day respectfully represents as follows:

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

From the outset of these cases, the Debtors demonstrated their commitment to completing the chapter 11 process as quickly as possible. As counsel to the Debtors, Jones Day aggressively pursued the Debtors' goals of achieving an expeditious reorganization of their businesses, deleveraging a heavily-burdened balance sheet, returning the Debtors to profitability

In the Fee Auditor's Final Report Regarding the Interim Fee Application of Jones Day for the First Period (the "First Fee Auditor Report"), the Fee Auditor objected to \$1,566.71 in expenses attributable to local transportation charges, which expenses were not approved on an interim basis by the First Interim Fee Order, but with respect to which Jones Day, in its response (D.I. 1795) to the First Fee Auditor Report, reserved its right to request final approval. In the Fee Auditor's Final Report Regarding the Interim Fee Application of Jones Day for the Second Period (D.I. 2188) (the "Second Fee Auditor Report"), the Fee Auditor objected to \$3,147.92 in expenses attributable to local transportation charges, with respect to which Jones Day, in its response (D.I. 2239) to the Second Fee Auditor Report, reserved its right to request final approval. Jones Day and the Fee Auditor have agreed that: (a) Jones Day will not request final approval of any expenses attributable to local transportation charges incurred by its professionals outside the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. during the first and second interim fee periods (*i.e.*, \$1,903.42); (b) Jones Day will voluntarily reduce its request for reimbursement of expenses for the third interim period by the amount necessary to exclude those expenses attributable to local transportation charges incurred by Jones Day professionals outside the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. (*i.e.*, \$2,676.34); (c) the Fee Auditor will withdraw its objection to the reimbursement of all expenses attributable to local transportation charges incurred by Jones Day professionals within the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. during the first and second interim fee periods (*i.e.*, \$3,244.29); and (d) the Fee Auditor will not object to the reimbursement of those expenses attributable to local transportation charges incurred by Jones Day professionals within the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. during the third interim fee period (*i.e.*, \$739.73).

and maximizing the value of their estates for the benefit of all parties. With these goals in mind, the process of developing a plan of reorganization began in earnest even prior to the commencement of these cases on February 23, 2004 (the "Petition Date").

Prepetition Restructuring Negotiations

In the weeks leading up to the Petition Date, in an effort to restructure their funded debt, the Debtors, with the assistance of Jones Day and the Debtors' financial advisors and investment bankers: (i) solicited interest from (A) potential equity investors with experience in investing in financially troubled companies and (B) various alternative financing sources regarding the refinancing of all, or a portion of, certain of the Debtors' prepetition credit facilities; and (ii) entered into lengthy discussions with (A) an ad hoc committee consisting of certain holders (collectively, the "Old Senior Subordinated Noteholders") of the Debtors' 10% senior subordinated notes due February 1, 2009 in the aggregate principal amount of \$100 million and (B) certain holders (collectively, the "Old Senior Secured Noteholders") of the Debtors' 18% senior secured notes due October 25, 2008 in the aggregate principal amount of \$75 million (the "Old Senior Secured Notes"), regarding the restructuring of such debt obligations. Also prior to the Petition Date, the Debtors entered into a commitment agreement (as amended, the "Commitment Agreement") that, among other things, contemplated an investment in the reorganized Debtors by certain Old Senior Subordinated Noteholders and certain third party accredited investors, the proceeds of which were intended, among other things, to redeem (and, ultimately, did redeem) the Old Senior Secured Notes.

Jones Day further assisted the Debtors in taking substantial steps towards obtaining, negotiating the terms of and documenting an initial and a second debtor in possession financing facility and exit financing by executing two letter agreements with Silver Point Finance, LLC ("Silver Point") pursuant to which Silver Point committed to provide the Debtors

with: (i) an interim debtor in possession credit facility with availability of up to \$75 million to cover the Debtors' working capital needs upon the commencement of the bankruptcy cases; (ii) a \$305 million debtor in possession credit facility that contemplated (A) the refinancing of the interim debtor in possession credit facility and (B) the refinancing and repayment of amounts outstanding under certain of the Debtors' prepetition credit facilities; and (iii) a \$310 million senior secured credit facility to be entered into by the Debtors upon the effective date (the "Effective Date") of the Second Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization of Debtors and Debtors in Possession (as amended or modified, the "Plan"), which was filed with the Court on July 30, 2004.

The Plan Confirmation Process

Subsequent to the Petition Date, Jones Day, on behalf of the Debtors, continued to negotiate the terms of the Debtors' proposed plan of reorganization with their stakeholder constituencies. For example, Jones Day participated in extensive discussions and negotiations with, among others: (i) the statutory committee of unsecured creditors appointed in these chapter 11 cases (the "Creditors' Committee") with respect to nearly every issue germane to the Debtors' reorganization, including the treatment of claims held by the Old Senior Subordinated Noteholders and the Old Senior Secured Noteholders and amendments to the Commitment Agreement; (ii) an ad hoc committee of holders of the Old Senior Secured Notes regarding the potential treatment of claims held by Old Senior Secured Noteholders under a plan; and (iii) counsel to certain of the Debtors' asbestos- and silica-related personal injury tort claimants (collectively, the "Tort Claimants") regarding the Debtors' proposed pass-through treatment of such claimants under the Plan as well as the possibility of settlement of the underlying tort claims of such claimants.

With the significant assistance of Jones Day, these discussions and negotiations led to the filing with this Court of: (i) the Joint Plan of Reorganization of Debtors and Debtors in Possession, on April 27, 2004; (ii) the Disclosure Statement Pursuant to Section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code for the Joint Plan of Reorganization of Debtors and Debtors in Possession, on May 21, 2004; (iii) the First Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization of Debtors and Debtors in Possession and First Amended Disclosure Statement Pursuant to Section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code for the Joint Plan of Reorganization of Debtors and Debtors in Possession, on July 1, 2004; and (iv) the Plan and the Second Amended Disclosure Statement Pursuant to Section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code for the Joint Plan of Reorganization of Debtors and Debtors in Possession (the "Disclosure Statement"), on July 30, 2004.

Both (i) the hearing to approve the Disclosure Statement as containing adequate information and (ii) the five-day hearing (replete with testimony and evidence) held to consider confirmation of the Plan were hotly contested by various creditor constituencies (including certain of the Old Senior Secured Noteholders and Tort Claimants), as well as certain of the Debtors' shareholders and a consortium (the "Consortium") of potential buyers seeking to purchase substantially all of the Debtors' assets. Jones Day advised the Debtors throughout this adversarial plan confirmation process, responded to the various objections filed and conducted the hearings in question, ultimately helping the Debtors to achieve successful outcomes to both. In close connection therewith, Jones Day assisted the Debtors in (i) responding to, and ultimately obtaining summary judgment upon, an adversary complaint filed by certain of the Old Senior Secured Noteholders and (ii) negotiating a settlement of approximately 30,000 claims held by the Tort Claimants. On August 4, 2004, the Court entered an order approving the Disclosure Statement as containing adequate information within the meaning of section 1125 of the

Bankruptcy Code (D.I. 1447). On November 17, 2004, the Court entered an order confirming the Plan (D.I. 1945).

Implementing the Plan

The success of the Plan development, confirmation and implementation process required the coordinated and dedicated efforts of numerous Jones Day bankruptcy, finance, securities, corporate, tax, litigation and employee benefits attorneys over the course of these cases to address the myriad of complex restructuring issues faced by the Debtors.

In particular, the relatively novel restructuring of the Debtors' businesses contemplated by the Plan required sustained and creative effort on the part of Jones Day's teams of corporate and securities attorneys. The Plan provided for, among other things, the issuance by the Debtors of: (i) 90,000,000 shares of new common stock; (ii) warrants to be distributed to the Debtors' former shareholders that entitled them to purchase fractional shares of new common stock; and (iii) 30,000,000 shares of preferred stock to be distributed among (A) those Old Senior Subordinated Noteholders, as well as certain third-party accredited investors, party to the Commitment Agreement and (B) those Old Senior Subordinated Noteholders that were not party to the Commitment Agreement, pursuant to a rights offering. In connection with these securities offerings, Jones Day, on an expedited basis, assisted the Debtors with preparing and submitting numerous filings to the United States Securities and Exchange Commission, including: (i) a form S-1 registration statement (the "S-1"), filed on May 14, 2004; (ii) an amendment to the S-1, filed on November 19, 2004; (iii) a resale form S-1, filed on January 27, 2005; and (iv) various other documents (e.g., an S-8, a 10-K, various 8-Ks and 10-Qs).

The Administration of the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases

Concurrently with all of these Plan-related activities, Jones Day took a leading role in both the day-to-day administration of the Debtors' chapter 11 cases and in the effort to

minimize the adverse impact of the Debtors' chapter 11 filings on the ongoing operation of the Debtors' businesses. For example, upon the commencement of these cases, Jones Day assisted the Debtors in stabilizing their businesses and achieving a "soft landing" in chapter 11 through a series of motions in the initial weeks of these cases to address a variety of specific business concerns. Among other things, these motions and related activities permitted the Debtors to (i) pay prepetition employee wages and benefits without interruption, (ii) honor prepetition obligations to customers necessary to preserve key business relationships, (iii) pay the prepetition claims of critical vendors and service providers essential to the continued operation of the Debtors' businesses, (iv) establish and maintain essential cash management procedures, (v) obtain interim and final debtor in possession financing, as described above, (vi) cement both the Debtors' insurance coverage and their ability to obtain bonds necessary to their businesses, and (vii) resolve numerous other important administrative issues.

Throughout these cases, Jones Day also assisted the Debtors in numerous other matters in order to (i) reduce the complexity and expense associated with these chapter 11 cases and (ii) maximize the value of the Debtors' estates for the benefit of all stakeholders. For example, Jones Day prepared and filed objections on the Debtors' behalf to motions filed by certain of the Debtors' shareholders and Tort Claimants seeking the appointment of official committees to represent their interests, which motions were denied. Further, Jones Day assisted the Debtors in evaluating and responding to the numerous offers from the Consortium to purchase substantially all of the Debtors' assets, and the multiple motions filed by the Consortium in connection therewith.

During these cases, Jones Day also devoted significant time to, among other things, the following: (i) assisting in the preparation of voluminous schedules of assets and

liabilities, statements of financial affairs and other documents required by the Court or the United States trustee (the "U.S. Trustee"); (ii) addressing and resolving requests for relief from the automatic stay imposed by section 362 of the Bankruptcy Code and other requests by creditors for relief from the Court; (iii) completing the steps necessary for the Debtors to retain estate professionals and resolve other issues relating to the retention and payment of professionals; and (iv) addressing numerous other bankruptcy and corporate issues that arose in the ordinary course of the Debtors' businesses during the pendency of these cases.

Conclusion

In sum, Jones Day's services in connection with the foregoing matters and the other matters described in this Final Application and the Monthly Applications demonstrate Jones Day's central role in enabling the Debtors to achieve their business and legal objectives in these cases. Jones Day believes that its efforts on these various matters were instrumental in (i) achieving confirmation of the Plan less than nine months after the Petition Date, which Plan provided for a 100% payout to all of the Debtors' secured claimants and their general unsecured creditors; (ii) accomplishing the Debtors' expeditious emergence from chapter 11 on the Effective Date, less than one year after the Petition Date; (iii) addressing the various issues that arose in these cases efficiently and effectively, with minimal disruption to the Debtors' businesses or, whenever possible, the need for involvement of the Court; and (iv) maximizing the value of the Debtors' estates for the direct benefit of the Debtors' stakeholders. Because of the substantial success that Jones Day helped bring to these cases, Jones Day submits that it is entitled to the interim and final allowance of the fees and reimbursement of the expenses requested herein.

BACKGROUND

General Background

1. The Debtors commenced their respective reorganization cases on the Petition Date by filing voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Debtors' chapter 11 cases have been consolidated for procedural purposes only and are being administered jointly.

2. The Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and Section XII.2 of the Plan. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).

Retention of Jones Day

3. On February 24, 2004, the Debtors filed the application to retain and employ Jones Day as their counsel (the "Retention Application"). On March 23, 2004, the Court entered an order (D.I. 221) (the "Retention Order") authorizing the retention of Jones Day as the Debtors' counsel to perform any and all necessary or appropriate legal services on behalf of the Debtors in connection with these chapter 11 cases, nunc pro tunc as of the Petition Date. A copy of the Retention Order is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

4. As described in the Retention Application, Jones Day charged for its services in these cases in accordance with its ordinary and customary hourly rates in effect on the dates that services were rendered. These rates were identical to those charged by Jones Day for similar services in other bankruptcy and nonbankruptcy matters.

5. In this Final Application, Jones Day seeks the final allowance of compensation for services rendered and reimbursement of related expenses incurred in the Debtors' chapter 11 cases. Pursuant to section III.A.1.f.ii.A of the Plan, all applications for final

allowance of compensation and reimbursement of related expenses are due no later than 60 days after the Effective Date, or April 1, 2005. To the best of Jones Day's knowledge, this Final Application complies with: (a) sections 330(a) and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code; (b) Bankruptcy Rule 2016; (c) the Interim Compensation Order; (d) the applicable provisions of the Guidelines for Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals adopted by the Office of the U.S. Trustee (the "Guidelines"); (e) Rule 2016-2 of the Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Local Rules"); and (f) the Fee Order.

COMPENSATION PAID TO JONES DAY AND ITS SOURCES

6. Through the date of this Final Application, the aggregate total received by Jones Day from the Debtors in connection with services rendered during the Compensation Period totals \$5,307,007.37. Jones Day has not received payment from any source other than the Debtors in connection with these chapter 11 cases. None of the above-referenced payments has been shared by Jones Day with any other party. No agreement or understanding exists between Jones Day or any third person for the sharing of compensation, except as permitted by section 504(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 2016 with respect to sharing of compensation between and among partners of Jones Day. All the services for which compensation is requested in this Final Application were rendered at the request of, and solely on behalf of, the Debtors, and not on behalf of any other entity.

activities performed by Jones Day professionals and paraprofessionals during the Compensation Period.

Summary of Services Rendered by Jones Day

9. The Jones Day partners, associates and paraprofessionals who have rendered services to the Debtors, as well as the hourly billing rates of, number of hours worked by and total fees attributable to each professional and paraprofessional, are all identified on the cover sheets attached hereto. In connection with the Debtors' chapter 11 cases, Jones Day attorneys and paraprofessionals expended a total of 20,860.75 hours during the Compensation Period.

10. The services rendered to the Debtors by Jones Day during the Compensation Period can be organized into the subject matter categories generally described below. More detailed explanations of the actual services provided to the Debtors are provided in the time details attached to the Monthly Applications.

a. Case Administration.

Fees: \$44,849.00 Total Hours: 302.55

This category includes all matters related to the daily case administration of the Debtors' complex chapter 11 cases, including the maintenance of a detailed work in process report and an internal pleadings index.

b. Creditor Inquiries.

Fees: \$16,864.60 Total Hours: 45.30

This category includes all matters related to responding to general inquiries from creditors.

c. Meetings.

Fees: \$100,320.00 Total Hours: 178.90

This category includes all matters related to preparing for and attending meetings with the Debtors and the various parties in interest in these chapter 11 cases, including, among others, the Creditors' Committee, the U.S. Trustee, the Debtors' financial advisors and the Debtors' various lenders and bondholder constituencies.

d. Executory Contracts/Unexpired Leases.

Fees: \$129,044.20 Total Hours: 568.60

This category includes all matters related to counseling the Debtors about their rights and obligations under certain executory contracts and unexpired leases, as well as all matters related to the assumption, assumption and assignment or rejection of such contracts and leases.

e. Automatic Stay/Adequate Protection.

Fees: \$96,520.50 Total Hours: 433.40

This category includes all matters related to the imposition of the automatic stay under section 362 of the Bankruptcy Code and the adequate protection of creditor interests.

f. Plan of Reorganization/Disclosure Statement.

Fees: \$1,733,885.40 Total Hours: 5,102.20

This category includes all matters related to: (1) the formulation, negotiation and drafting of the various iterations of the Plan and Disclosure Statement, as described in the Preliminary Statement above; (2) the promulgation,

solicitation of acceptances and rejections, confirmation and implementation of the Plan; and (3) the drafting and filing of responses to the various objections filed with respect to the Plan and the Disclosure Statement.

g. Use, Sale, Lease of Assets.

Fees: \$137,712.00 Total Hours: 393.00

This category includes all matters related to the acquisition, disposition and other postpetition use of estate property.

h. Cash Collateral/DIP Financing/Other Financing.

Fees: \$981,117.00 Total Hours: 3,411.30

This category includes all matters related to the negotiation, documentation and closing of the Debtors' interim and final debtor in possession financing facilities, as well as the Debtors' confirmation/exit facility, and all related cash collateral issues.

i. Claims Administration.

Fees: \$62,519.20 Total Hours: 242.70

This category includes all matters related to the administration of claims against the Debtors, including any objections by the Debtors thereto, and all related contested matters.

j. Court Hearings.

Fees: \$364,576.30 Total Hours: 774.00

This category includes all matters related to preparation for, attendance at and participation in the various omnibus hearings regularly held before the Court throughout these chapter 11 cases, as well as the contested initial four-day hearing

to consider confirmation of the Plan and the further evidentiary hearing on the re-opened record.

k. General Corporate/Real Estate.

Fees: \$1,799,759.40 Total Hours: 5,617.40

This category includes all matters related to the general corporate governance of the Debtors, as well as the various securities and corporate matters integral to the implementation of the Plan, including the preparation and filing of the S-1 (and all amendments thereto) and the resale form S-1, the negotiation of the Commitment Agreement and the various amendments thereto as well as assisting with the Debtors' numerous 10-K, 10-Q and 8-K filings.

l. Schedules/SOFA/U.S. Trustee Reports.

Fees: \$59,114.10 Total Hours: 214.00

This category includes all matters related to the preparation of the Debtors' schedules of assets and liabilities and statements of financial affairs, as well as the Debtors' monthly operating reports and other reports required by the U.S. Trustee or the Court.

m. Employee Matters.

Fees: \$115,155.10 Total Hours: 384.60

This category includes all matters related to employee wages and benefits, pensions, certain stock, incentive and severance programs, key employee retention, issues implicating the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 and retiree benefits.

n. Environmental Matters.

Fees: \$210.00 Total Hours: 0.40

This category includes all matters related to the Debtors' environmental obligations.

o. Tax Advice.

Fees: \$27,774.50 Total Hours: 72.60

This category includes all matters related to, among others, federal and state income, property, employment, excise and franchise taxes, as well as various tax issues related to the Plan.

p. Litigation/Adversary Proceedings.

Fees: \$254,235.60 Total Hours: 966.50

This category includes all matters related to the following adversary proceedings: (1) MW Post Portfolio Fund Ltd, et al. v. Norwest Bank Minnesota, N.A., n/k/a Wells Fargo Bank, MN, N.A., et al., Adv. Proc. No. 04-54122 (DDS); (2) Oglebay Norton Marine Servs. Co., LLC v. Huron Lime, Inc., Adv. Proc. No. 04-54136 (DDS); and (3) Oglebay Norton Co. v. Port, Adv. Proc. No. 04-54939 (DDS).

q. Professional Retention/Fee Issues.

Fees: \$78,677.70 Total Hours: 403.20

This category includes all matters related to the review and/or preparation of: (1) applications to retain and/or compensate other professionals; and (2) objections to applications for compensation filed by other professionals in these chapter 11 cases.

r. Fee Application Preparation.

Fees: \$104,103.60 Total Hours: 593.30

This category includes all matters related to the preparation of Monthly Applications, interim fee application requests and this Final Application.

s. Nonworking Travel.

Fees: \$67,436.25 Total Hours: 294.30

This category includes all travel time not otherwise chargeable. In accordance with Local Rule 2016, Jones Day has only invoiced the Debtors for 50 percent of its professionals' nonworking travel time. Accordingly, the fee amount set forth above represents 50 percent of the nonworking travel fees incurred by Jones Day during the Compensation Period.

t. Asbestos Matters.

Fees: \$206,994.30 Total Hours: 704.70

This category includes all matters related to asbestos- and silica-related personal injury tort claims against the Debtors, and the settlement of a significant portion thereof.

u. Shareholder Investigation.

Fees: \$43,116.50 Total Hours: 157.80

This category includes all matters related to a complaint, filed December 15, 2004, by one of the Debtors' former equity holders against certain of the Debtors' current and former directors and officers.

Legal Argument

11. Section 330(a)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code provides, in pertinent part, for the payment of:

(A) reasonable compensation for actual, necessary services rendered by the trustee, examiner, professional person, or attorney and by any paraprofessional person employed by any such person; and

(B) reimbursement for actual, necessary expenses.

11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(1) (2004). To grant a request for compensation pursuant to section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, a court must find that such request is reasonable. The reasonableness of a compensation request is determined by taking into account the nature, extent and value of the services provided by the professional and the cost of comparable services in nonbankruptcy contexts. See Zolfo Cooper & Co. v. Sunbeam-Oster Co., 50 F.3d 253, 258 (3d Cir. 1995); In re Busy Beaver Bldg. Ctr., Inc., 19 F.3d 833, 849 (3d Cir. 1994). The Third Circuit has adopted a "market-driven approach" to compensation requests that focuses primarily on the cost of comparable services in nonbankruptcy contexts. See Zolfo Cooper, 50 F.3d at 258; see also Busy Beaver, 19 F.3d at 849-50 (recognizing that Congress intended as a matter of policy that bankruptcy practitioners should be compensated at the same rates as nonbankruptcy practitioners in order to attract and retain top caliber attorneys to the practice of bankruptcy law); In re Fine Paper Antitrust Litig., 751 F.2d 562, 583 (3d Cir. 1984) ("The value of an attorney's time generally is reflected in his normal billing rate."). This market-based approach permits flexibility in billing arrangements. Although the "lodestar" method (hourly rate multiplied by hours worked) is currently the most widely utilized method for compensation arrangements, the Third Circuit recognizes that, if the market were to dictate some other form of compensation arrangement, section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code is flexible enough to accommodate requests

for compensation on that basis. See Busy Beaver, 19 F.3d at 849 n.21, 856. Regardless of the manner in which compensation is calculated, however, "the baseline rule is for firms to receive their customary rates." Zolfo Cooper, 50 F.3d at 259.

12. The rates charged by Jones Day in these chapter 11 cases are the same rates charged by Jones Day for comparable nonbankruptcy services rendered during the Compensation Period, and application of the foregoing criteria amply justifies the compensation and expense reimbursement requested in this Final Application. Moreover, Jones Day's fees are not unusual given the complexity and size of the Debtors' chapter 11 cases, and they are commensurate with fees that Jones Day has been awarded in other chapter 11 cases and that other attorneys of comparable experience and expertise charge on a regular basis in chapter 11 cases.

13. Jones Day has utilized the lodestar method for calculating its compensation requests submitted in this Final Application. Jones Day's lodestar calculation is based upon hourly rates that are well within the range of rates that are charged by comparable firms in other large bankruptcy cases. Accordingly, Jones Day's lodestar calculation is reasonable under section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code. See Pennsylvania v. Del. Valley Citizens' Council for Clean Air, 478 U.S. 546, 565 (1986); In re Drexel Burnham Lambert Group, Inc., 133 B.R. 13, 22 (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. 1991).

14. The professional services rendered by Jones Day during the Compensation Period required a high degree of professional competence and expertise so that the numerous issues requiring evaluation and response by the Debtors could be addressed with skill and dispatch. The provision of such services, therefore, required the expenditure of substantial time and effort. Jones Day submits that the services rendered to the Debtors were performed

efficiently, effectively and economically and that the results obtained have provided a significant benefit to the reorganized Debtors.

Actual and Necessary Expenses Incurred by Jones Day

15. Summaries and details of actual and necessary expenses incurred by Jones Day in rendering services to the Debtors during the Compensation Period are attached to each of the Monthly Applications previously filed with the Court and are incorporated herein by reference.⁴

16. Jones Day maintains the following policies with respect to expenses:

- No amortization of the cost of any investment, equipment or capital outlay is included in Jones Day's request for reimbursement of expenses. In addition, for those items or services that Jones Day justifiably purchased or contracted from a third party (such as outside copy services), Jones Day seeks reimbursement only for the exact amount billed to Jones Day by the third party vendor and paid by Jones Day to the third party vendor.
- Photocopying by Jones Day was charged at \$.15 per page in accordance with the Local Rules. To the extent practical, Jones Day utilized less expensive, outside copying services.
- Telecopying by Jones Day was charged at the cost of the long distance call required to send the facsimile. The Firm does not charge clients for local facsimiles, inbound facsimiles, interoffice facsimiles or facsimile costs of less than \$1.00.
- Mileage was charged at the prevailing rate allowed by the Internal Revenue Service for tax deductions for mileage.
- All airfare expenses are for coach class travel. Charges for airline travel include the cost of each airline ticket used in connection with the provision of services to the Debtors' estates plus, for each airline ticket issued by the travel service regularly used by Jones

⁴ As noted above, Jones Day will provide the Court with complete copies of all previously-filed Monthly Applications (and all related documentation) prior to the hearing on this matter.

Day, a \$40 transaction fee to cover travel service expenses.⁵ Jones Day professionals are to incur only reasonable meal, lodging and car rental costs when traveling on client matters

- Computer assisted legal research was used when time pressures rendered it impracticable to conduct such research manually or where the use of such computer services was determined to be more cost efficient. Computer-assisted research is billed on a per-search and/or per-minute basis, depending upon the provider. Jones Day used computer research in the following instances in connection with certain internal legal analysis and in preparation of internal memoranda and pleadings filed with the Court:
 - case law research regarding particularly important issues; and
 - shepardization of cases cited in pleadings filed with the Court. With computer assistance, the total shepardization and research time was greatly reduced. To complete this shepardizing and research manually would have taken significantly more lawyer or paraprofessional time, resulting in a greater cost to the Debtors' estates.
- Jones Day generally does not charge for postage less than \$1.00. Postage is billed at actual cost for postage over \$1.00 and for large mailings even if individual item postage is less than \$1.00. Overnight delivery services and messenger services were used when time pressures rendered it impracticable to use regular mail services. Messenger services are billed at the actual rates charged by comparable, outside delivery services or the actual cost of such services.
- Jones Day does not charge for telephone calls between its offices or for local or long distance calls less than \$1.00. Long distance telephone charges over \$1.00 and operator assisted conference calls are billed at actual cost.
- Jones Day bills for the actual cost of staff overtime only when staff overtime services are used for the needs of its clients and not for Jones Day's own convenience.

⁵ The \$40 transaction fee described above represents the amount charged by Jones Day's travel service at the close of the Compensation Period. Prior to the adjustment of this transaction fee during the Compensation Period, Jones Day's travel service had charged a transaction fee of \$30.

Sections 330(a)(1)(B) and 503(b)(4) of the Bankruptcy Code permit reimbursement for actual, necessary expenses. See Zolfo Cooper, 50 F.3d at 258; White Motor Credit Corp., 50 B.R. 885, 891-92 (Bankr. N.D. Ohio 1985). Jones Day believes that those expenses for which final approval of reimbursement is sought in this Final Application satisfy the standards set forth in section 330(a)(1)(B) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Local Rules and the Guidelines.

Certification

In accordance with Local Rule 2016(f) and the Guidelines, the Certification of Heather Lennox is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Notice

17. No trustee or examiner has been appointed in these chapter 11 cases. Pursuant to the Interim Compensation Order, notice of this Final Application has been given to (a) the Debtors, (b) the U.S. Trustee, (c) counsel to the former Creditors' Committee, (d) counsel to the Post-Confirmation Lenders, (e) counsel to the former *ad hoc* committee of senior secured noteholders and (f) the Fee Auditor. In light of the nature of the relief requested herein, the Debtors submit that no other or further notice is required.

WHEREFORE, Jones Day respectfully requests (i) allowance on a final basis of (A) compensation of \$6,392,348.75 for services rendered in connection with these chapter 11 cases during the Compensation Period and (B) reimbursement of expenses incurred during the Compensation Period of \$345,913.75, for a total of \$6,738,262.50; (ii) authorization of the payment to Jones Day by the Debtors of all amounts requested herein, less those amounts already

paid to Jones Day by the Debtors in accordance with the Interim Compensation Order; and

(iii) such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
