16 On September 14, 2004, the court heard the Final Application For Compensation and
17 Reimbursement of Expenses By Deloitte & Touche LLP ("Application"). Adequate notice was
18 given to interested parties. Appearances at the hearing were noted on the record. The
19 Application requested an award of final compensation in the amount of \$8,627,779.54
20 (consisting of \$8,604,707.10 in fees for services and \$23,072.44 in expense reimbursement) for
21 the entirety of this case, including \$860,402.23 (consisting of \$859,907.40 in fees for services
22 and \$494.83 in expense reimbursement) for the time interval from December 1, 2003, through
23 April 12, 2004. After considering the Application and any statements made at the hearing, and
24 good cause appearing,

25 It is hereby ordered that:

26 Deloitte & Touche LLP ("Applicant") is awarded final compensation in the amount of
27 \$8,627,779.54 (consisting of \$8,604,707.10 in fees for services and \$23,072.44 in expense

1 reimbursement) for the entirety of this case. Such final compensation award includes (1)
2 amounts previously awarded and paid to Applicant as interim compensation and (2) \$860,402.23
3 (consisting of \$859,907.40 in fees for services and \$494.83 in expense reimbursement) for the
4 time interval from December 1, 2003, through April 12, 2004 ("the Incremental Award").
5 Debtor is authorized and directed to pay Applicant the full amount of the Incremental Award,
6 less amounts previously paid.
