and (b) an amount of fees actually and necessarily incurred on PG&E's behalf which do not exceed one hundred and ten percent (110%) of the "Average Monthly Fees" set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto (the "Monthly Allowed Interim Fees"). In the event that Special Counsel's fees for any month exceed the Monthly Allowed Interim Fees, then PG&E shall provide the Committee and the UST with copies of invoices of the Special Counsel whose fees exceed such amount; provided, however, that PG&E shall in any event be authorized to pay such Special Counsel an amount equal to such Special Counsel's Monthly Allowed Interim Fees in any event.
