14	Blake Dawson Waldron ("BDW") submits its third application ("Fee Application")					
15	for an award of interim compensation for professional fees incurred from the					
16	period December 1, 1998 to and including February 5, 1999 (the "Application					
17	Period") and its application for final compensation for professional fees and					
18	reimbursable expenses incurred during the period from July 16, 1998 to and					
19	including February 5, 1999 and respectfully represents:					
20	1. On January 16, 1998, the above-named Debtors ("Debtors") filed a petition					
21	for relief under Chapter 11, Title 11, of the United States Code in the United States					
22	Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada.					
23	2. On July 24, 1998, Debtors filed their <u>Application For An Order Approving</u>					
24	The Retention And Employment Of Blake Dawson Waldron As Special Counsel					
25	("Retention Application"). On August 6, 1998, such employment was approved by					
26	this Court.					
27	3. BDW, as Australian special counsel for Debtors, hereby applies for the					

payment of interim compensation for services rendered and reimbursement of

expenses incurred during the Application Period.

4. BDW seeks payment of compensation in the amount of Australian \$3,450.00 (Australian \$ is hereafter referred to as "A\$"), representing 100% of the fees for services rendered during the Application Period. Members of BDW expended a total of 8 hours 25 minutes in the provision of services to the Debtors during the Application Period.

- 5. A copy of the billing statement, a summary setting out: (a) name of each individual that performed services for Debtors during the application period; (b) the status of such individuals as partner or associate; (c) the hourly billing rate applicable to each such individual; and (d) the time expended by those individuals during the Application Period are attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 6. During the Application Period, BDW performed services for Debtors involving litigation support for Debtors against Bateman Project Engineering Pty Ltd, Kinhill Pacific Pty Ltd and Kilborn Engineering Pacific Pty Ltd ("collectively, "BKK"). As provided in the Retention Application, BDW was employed by Debtors as special counsel to represent the interests of PGI and PGC throughout the BKK litigation, and to continue the prosecution of such litigation by filing a Statement of Claim against BKK in the Federal Court of Australia, New South Wales District Registry ("Federal Court"). During BDW's previous application periods (from July 16, 1998 through November 30, 1998, BDW prepared the Statement of Claim and it was filed in the Federal Court. BDW monitored the progress of and attended Court proceedings pursuant to this litigation in the Federal Court. In addition, BDW prepared its fee application for the prior application periods and attended the bankruptcy court hearing on such applications. In this way, the services of BDW have greatly benefited the estate. BDW submits that the services provided by it are in now way duplicative services provided by the other law firms employed in this matter.
