AMENDED SECOND AND FINAL COMPENSATION APPLICATION FOR ERWIN THOMPSON & HASCHEFF

- 2. On May 15, 1998, Debtors filed their Omnibus Motion for Employment nunc pro tunc as of January 16, 1998, of Erwin Thompson & Hascheff, among others, as Special Counsel ("Retention Application"). On June 26, 1998, such employment was approved by this Court.

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3. ETH, as special counsel for Debtors, applies for the payment of compensation for services rendered and reimbursement of expenses incurred during the Application Period.

- 4. 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
