Beck, as liquidating trustee of the SPFC Liquidating Trust (the "Trust"), and KPMG LLP (formerly known as KPMG Peat Marwick LLP ("KPMG"), and the court having considered the final application for chapter 11 professional compensation filed by KPMG on or about August 20, 1999 (the "Final Application"), and finding that such notice and opportunity for hearing as required under the circumstances has been given and that final compensation is appropriate under 11 U.S.C. § 330 as set forth below, it is now, hereby

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Final Application, the second interim application for chapter 11 professional compensation filed by KPMG on or about June 11, 1999, and the unpaid portion of

The Trust is hereby authorized and directed to make the payment to 4 KPMG in the amount of \$480,000 to the following address: KPMG LLP, Dept. 0990, P.O. 5 Box 120001, Dallas, TX 75312-0990. 6 3. Entry of this order or the Trust's stipulation thereto is not intended nor 7 shall it be construed as a bar, waiver, or a release of any claims of any nature, whether asserted 8 or unasserted, against KPMG, its affiliates, partners, agents, or employees, other than that 9 debtor's payment on invoice 11871 to KPMG was avoidable under Chapter 5 of the United States 10 Bankruptcy Code. Nor shall entry of this order be construed as a bar, waiver, or release of any 11 defenses or counterclaim that KPMG, its affiliates, partners, agents, or employees may have to 12 such claims. Neither the Trust nor KPMG shall offer evidence of this order, of this court's 13 allowance of any application by KPMG for compensation or reimbursement of expenses for 14 services rendered for debtor or the Trust from the petition date through July 31, 1999, or of any 15 payment by debtor or the Trust to KPMG for those services in any case or proceeding except to 16 prove that no additional amounts may be due from debtor or the Trust for those services. 17 18 19 United States Bankruptcy Judge 20 IT IS SO STIPULATED: 21 KPMG LLP 22 23 By nes D.
