ORDER ALLOWING COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES TO BURNS, DAY & PRESNELL, P.A. AND DAVID W. BOONE, EXAMINER

This Matter having come on before the Court after notice to counsel for the Debtor, the Committee of Unsecured Creditors, the Bankruptcy Administrator and counsel for parties who sought the appointment of an Equity Committee, the notice having been provided by the Examiner on February 21, 2003, to consider the Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Burns, Day & Presnell, P.A. and David W. Boone as Examiner (the "Application"); the Notice requiring any objections to be filed twenty days from February 21, 2003, no objections having been filed and the time for filing such objections having expired; and after considering the matters set forth therein, the Court finds that the compensation and reimbursement of expenses requested therein are reasonable for the services rendered by Counsel for the Debtor, applying the standards set forth in Section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code and applicable case law.

Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby ordered that counsel for the Debtor is allowed interim compensation in the amount of \$\sumset \overline{F}, \frac{7/2}{2}\overline{F}\end{cases}\$ and is allowed reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$113.20 for the period from January 7, 2003 through January 31, 2003, which amounts are costs of administration in this case and shall be paid by the Debtor in accordance with the provisions of its confirmed Plan of Reorganization..
