CONSENT ORDER REGARDING BANKRUPTCY ADMINISTRATOR'S OBJECTION TO ALLOWANCE OF FEE APPLICATION OF ERNST & YOUNG LLP

This matter came on for hearing before the undersigned United States Bankruptcy Judge on the Application of Ernst & Young LLP for Final Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses and the Bankruptcy Administrator's objection thereto.

It appearing that the above-referenced debtor filed an application to retain Ernst & Young on December 20, 2002 and an order authorizing their retention was entered January 15, 2003 nunc pro tune to November 15, 2002.

It further appearing that the firm has filed an application seeking approval of professional fees and expenses incurred from the period of November 15, 2002 to February 9, 2003 and requesting compensation in the amount of \$251,062.00 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$1,178.00.

It further appearing that E&Y and the Bankruptcy Administrator have resolved the objection filed by the Bankruptcy Administrator and that both parties have consented to the relief set forth in this order.

NOW THEREFORE it is hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed that:

- 1. The maximum hourly rate requested by E&Y is reduced to \$500.00;
- 2. The amount charged for preparation of the employment and retention agreement, including the amounts charged for checking for conflicts of interest, is reduced to \$5000; and
- 3. E&Y is allowed compensation in the amount of \$191,000 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of 1,178.00.
