The independent public accounting and financial advisory firm of Arthur Andersen LLP ("Arthur Andersen" or the "Firm") submits this Seventh and Final Application for Approval of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses (the "Seventh And Final Application" or this "Application") for the period of July 1, 1998 through October 14, 1998 (the "Seventh Application Period") and hereby seeks final approval of all compensation and reimbursement of expenses previously approved on an interim basis for the periods of January 27, 1997 through April 30, 1997 (the "First Application Period"); May 1, 1997 through June 30, 1997 (the "Second Application Period"); July 1, 1997 through August 31, 1997 (the "Third Application Period"); September 1, 1997 through December 31, 1997 (the "Fourth Application Period"); January 1, 1998 through March 31, 1998 (the "Fifth Application Period"); and April 1, 1998 through June 30 1998 (the "Sixth Application Period"). ### INTRODUCTION

Final Application, Arthur Andersen respectfully represents as follows:

1. Through this Seventh And Final Application, Arthur Andersen seeks approval of fees and expenses incurred in connection with the Firm's representation of Stratosphere Corporation and Stratosphere Gaming Corp., debtors and debtors-in-possession herein (collectively, "Stratosphere" or the "Debtors", and each individually, a "Debtor"). During the Seventh Application Period, the Firm's professionals and paraprofessionals expended a total of 677.1 hours. The professional fees for such services, computed at Arthur Andersen's standard hourly rates for similar services, are \$91,472.50.

Certain audit/compliance related services were performed pursuant to the terms of a fixed-fee agreement entered into by Arthur Andersen and Stratosphere (see Exhibit "N"). To the extent actual professional fees incurred in the

rendition of such services differed from the fixed-fee amount agreed upon

- 2. During the period from January 27, 1997 through October 14, 1998 ("Case Period"), the Firm's professionals and paraprofessionals expended a total of 7,212.8 hours. The professional fees for such services, computed at Arthur Andersen's standard hourly rates for similar services, are \$1,111,216.00. Certain audit/compliance related services were performed pursuant to the terms of four fixed-fee agreements entered into by Arthur Andersen and Stratosphere (see Exhibits "K", "L", "M" and "N"). To the extent actual professional fees incurred in the rendition of such services differed from the fixed-fee amounts agreed upon (with respect to such services), Arthur Andersen adjusted the amount of professional fees billed in order to comply with the terms of the fixed-fee agreements. Accordingly, Arthur Andersen has applied downward adjustments totaling \$52,996.50 with respect to fees incurred during the Case Period, thereby reducing the net amount of fees billed to \$1,058,219.50. Accordingly, the Firm is seeking final approval for fees incurred during the Case Period in the net amount of \$1,058,219.50.
- 3. Arthur Andersen incurred ordinary and necessary expenses of \$21,879.59 during the Case Period.
- 4. The Firm recognizes that the fees incurred in these cases are substantial. However, when considered in light of the complexity of the issues involved, the type of services provided and the results achieved thus far, the Firm believes that the fees requested are reasonable under the circumstances and commensurate with the quality and quantity of services provided.

# SUMMARY OF FEE REQUEST

This Application is the Firm's seventh and final application and seeks approval, on a final basis, of compensation and reimbursement of expenses for services rendered to the Debtors, in amounts which have been or will be invoiced to the Debtors for the Case Period.

6. The Seventh And Final Application requests that this Court: (i) approve fees in the amount of \$1,058,219.50 and expenses in the amount of \$21,879.59 incurred by the Firm in connection with services rendered in these cases and (ii) award and order to be paid to the Firm the balance of any such fees and expenses incurred after deducting any retainer received by the Firm and any payments made on account of prior interim fee awards.

## Fees Requested

- Seventh Application Period: The Firm seeks allowance of compensation for the Seventh Application Period in the aggregate net amount of \$85,629.50.
- Case Period: The Firm also seeks allowance of compensation for the Case Period, in the aggregate amount of \$1,058,219.50. After taking into account the fees paid to the Firm pursuant to interim compensation orders (entered by this Court) and the Firms retainer, the following sums remain due and unpaid:
