possession, ("Debtors") in the above-captioned Chapter 11 case. Pursuant to this Final Application, G&S respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order:

- a) For the period from July 1, 1998, through the effective date, October 14, 1998, ("Effective Date") of the Restated Second Amended Plan of Reorganization dated February 26, 1998, ("Interim Application Period");
  - (i) Determining that the total amount of professional fees and expenses charged by G & S to the Debtors during the Interim Application Period are reasonable within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. §330(a);
  - (ii) Allowing G&S professional compensation in the amount of \$154,907.00 and reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$11,051.04; and
  - (iii) Authorizing the Reorganized Debtors to pay to G&S pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §331 all unpaid fees and expenses as allowed by the Court for the Interim Application Period; and
- b) For the period from the Petition Date, January 27, 1997, through the Effective Date, ("Entire Application Period");
  - (i) Determining that the total amount of professional fees charged by G&S to the Debtors during the Entire Application Period are reasonable within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. § 330(a);
  - (ii) Allowing G&S professional compensation in the amount of \$1,325,738.50 and reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$120,013.54, which includes fees totaling \$37,928.00 arising from a motion to disqualify G & S brought by Bob Stupak, which fees were deferred by the Bankruptcy Court to the Final Application and;

(iii) Authorizing the Debtors to pay to G&S the sum of \$37,928.00 in deferred fees; and

Allowing G&S to apply the sum of \$87,890.55, being the retainer paid (c) prior to the Petition Date, against the Interim Application Period award and Entire Application Period Award with the unpaid balance of such awards to be paid by Reorganized Debtors pursuant to this Final Application.

This Final Application is supported by the attached points and authorities and the exhibits to the Final Application, which contain descriptions and analysis of the professional services rendered and the expenses incurred by G&S.
