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**ORDER GRANTING INTERIM ALLOWANCE OF
COMPENSATION FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RENDERED
AND FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES**

Upon consideration of the applications of (i) Weil, Gotshal & Manges LLP, as attorneys for AI Realty Marketing of New York, Inc., Laser Acquisition Corporation, DDG I, Inc., Sunbeam Americas Holdings, Ltd. and substantially all of their direct and indirect domestic operating subsidiaries (collectively, the “Debtors”), filed September 30, 2002, (ii) Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP, as special corporate counsel for the Debtors, filed September 30, 2002, (iii) Moffett & Dillon P.C., as ordinary course professional for the Debtors, filed September 12, 2002, (iv) Momkus Ozog & McCluskey LLC, as ordinary course professional for the Debtors, filed September 27, 2002, (v) Kramer Levin Naftalis & Frankel LLP, as special intellectual property counsel for the Debtors, filed September 30, 2002, (vi) Cozen & O’Connor, as ordinary course professional for the Debtors, filed September 27, 2002 (collectively, the “Applicants”), seeking allowance of interim compensation for professional services rendered and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in connection therewith in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (collectively, the “Applications”); and a hearing having been held on

October 30, 2002 before this Court to consider the Applications (the “Hearing”); and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Applications and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and due notice of the Applications having been provided pursuant to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and it appearing that no other further notice need be given; and the Court having overruled any and all objections to the Applications not previously withdrawn or resolved; and for the reasons set forth more fully on the record of the Hearing, and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

ORDERED that pursuant to sections 330 and 331 of title 11 of the United States Code, the requests for allowance and payment of fees and reimbursement of expenses contained in the Applications are hereby granted in full, less in the case of each Applicant a five percent (5%) holdback in the amount of requested fees (the “Holdback”) to the extent the application does not already provide for such a Holdback, as set forth in Schedule A annexed hereto; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors are hereby authorized and directed upon the entry of this Order and receipt of appropriate wiring instructions from each Applicant to wire-transfer to each such Applicant the amount of fees and expenses as allowed herein.
