I. BACKGOUND

- 1. On January 11, 2005 (the "Petition Date") the Debtors filed a voluntary petitions in this Court under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"). The Debtor's Continue to manage and operate their businesses as debtors-in-possession.

There is an unpaid balance of \$6,473.50.

These services include:

- i. The review of all fee applications rendered by professionals in these cases through January 11, 2006.
- ii. Correspondence to each professional regarding issues and questions revolving around the fee applications.

iii. Resolution of all issues and questions.

iv. Issuance of Final Reports to the Court. In the application period, all issues

and questions were amicably resolved.
