5 This matter came before the Court pursuant to: (1) the "First And Final Application of Ernst &
6 Young LLP For Allowance and Payment of Compensation" filed by Ernst & Young LLP ("Ernst &
7 Young") on March 17, 1999 (the "Application). On March 24, 1999, Squire, Sanders & Dempsey
8 L.L.P., as counsel to the Debtors, served a copy of the "Notice and Order" regarding the Application
9 (the "Notice") to all parties on the Official Service List. The Notice provided that any objection or
10 response to the Application must be filed no later than April 20, 1999. No objections or responses were
11 timely filed, and on April 22, 1999, the Debtors filed a "Certificate of Service and No Objection"
12 evidencing same. In light of the foregoing, and good cause appearing therefor,

14 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

- 15 1. The Application shall be, and hereby is, allowed in the amount of \$258,000.
- 16 2. The above-captioned Debtors shall be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to pay the
17 allowed fees of Ernst & Young as set forth above forthwith, provided payment of no other
18 administrative expenses will be prejudiced thereby.
- 19 3. Since no timely objections were filed with respect to the Application, the status hearing
20 currently scheduled for April 27, 1999 at 1:00 p.m. shall be and hereby is vacated with respect to only
21 the Ernst & Young Application.
