**ORDER GRANTING FIRST AND FINAL APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION  
AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES OF PACHULSKI STANG  
ZIEHL YOUNG JONES & WEINTRAUB LLP, AS COUNSEL FOR THE  
LIMITED PURPOSE OF PURSUING AVOIDANCE ACTIONS ON  
BEHALF OF THE DEBTORS AND DEBTORS IN POSSESSION  
FOR THE PERIOD FROM DECEMBER 1, 2004 THROUGH JANUARY 20, 2006**


Pachulski Stang Ziehl Young Jones & Weintraub LLP (“PSZYJ&W”, or the “Firm”), counsel to the Debtors and Debtors in Possession in the above-captioned Chapter 11 cases (the “Debtors”) for the limited purpose of pursuing avoidance actions on behalf of the Debtors, hereby submits its First and Final Application for Compensation and for Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period from December 1, 2004 through January 20, 2006 (the “Final Application”). The Court has reviewed the Final Application and finds that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (b) notice of the Final Application, and any hearing on the Final Application, was adequate under the circumstances; and (c) all persons with standing have been afforded the opportunity to be heard on the Final Application. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Final Application is GRANTED, on a final basis. Debtors shall pay to PSZYJ&W the sum of \$30,580.50 as compensation and \$99.88 as reimbursement of

expenses, for a total of \$30,680.38 for services rendered and disbursements incurred by PSZYJ&W for the period December 1, 2004 through January 20, 2006.

ORDERED that to the extent PSZYJ&W has incurred fees and expenses in addition to the foregoing, PSZYJ&W may file one or more supplemental fee applications by following the interim compensation procedures set forth in the Administrative Order and submitting a certificate of no objection and order to the Court for final approval of such fees and expenses as may be reflected in any such supplemental fee application.
